Wardrobe – Blue Dress

Dress designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll. Doll patterns available on Gumnut Crochet blog.



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast 1
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity – contrast 2
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons x 2

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project

with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

Gumnut Crochet

Blue Flared Dress. Worked in rows from sleeve edge down. In main colour. Ch at beg of row doesn't count as hdc.
First hdc completed in ch space

- R1. Ch 26, turn,
R2. Hdc into third chain from hook, hdc in each ch, ch 2, turn – 24 hdc
R3. Hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc inc), ch 2, turn – 30 hdc
R4. Hdc in each of next 4 hdc, hdc inc), ch 2, turn – 36 hdc
R5. Hdc in each hdc, turn, ch 2 - 36 hdc

Skirt Flared Base

- R6. (Hdc in each of next 3 sc, 2 hdc in next sc), sl st, ch 2 – 45 hdc
R7. Hdc in each hdc – 45 hdc
R8. (Hdc in each of next 4 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc), join to round, sl st, ch 2 – 54 hdc
R9. (Hdc in each of next 5 hdc, hdc 2 in next hdc), sl st, ch 2 – 63 hdc
R10. (Hdc in each of next 6 hdc, hdc 2 in next hdc), sl st, ch 2 – 72 hdc
R11-15. Hdc in each of next hdc - 72 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Skirt Edge

- R16. In contrast colour 1 and back loops, hdc in each of next hdc – 72 hdc
R17. Hdc in each hdc – 72 hdc
R18. In contrast colour 2, and front loops from R16, sc in each front loop – 72 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Forming armholes

R1. In contrast colour 1, sl st into first sc in R1, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 1, turn – 32 sc

R6. In back loops, sc in each sc – 32 sc.

Neck Edging

R1. In contrast colour 2, sl st into first front loop from R6, sc in each front loop – 32 sc,

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Back edge opening

R1. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 4 sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole). Continue to pick up sc evenly down right edge, continuing up left neck edge (2 buttonholes on right side)

Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons

Small Bow – make 1

R1. Chain 6, sl st to join, in middle of ring, 2 sc, 1 hdc, dc, hdc, sl st, hdc, dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc, sl st to close

R2. 2sc in next sc, sc 1, (hdc, 1 dc) in next st, dc, hdc, sl st, hdc, dc, hdc, 2 sc

To make other side of bow, repeat R1-R2

Forming ties

R3. In centre of 2 bows ch 10, dc into 3rd chain from hook, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, sl st

R4. Repeat R3 for other tie

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew to dress

Headband

R1. In main colour, ch 45, join with sl st being careful not to twist chain, ch 2,

R2. Hdc in each ch, sl st - 45 hdc

R3. In contrast colour, ch 2, hdc in each hdc, sl st – 45 hdc

R4. In main colour, hdc 2, hdc in each hdc, sl st, ch 2 – 45 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Pull Up Scrunch Boots

R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc

R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc

R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc

R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R5. Sc in each back loops - 30 sc

R6-9. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc

R11. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc

R12-16. Sc in each sc – 19 sc

R17. Sl st to close round, ch 2, 2hdc in each sc, sl st, ch 1 – 38 hdc

R18. Sl st to close round, ch 1, 2 sc in each sc, sl st to close – 76 sc

Boot Edge

R19. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each loop – 30 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, decorate with button or bow, or leave as is
