

# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



### Wardrobe – Pebble Stitch Dress

Designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons x 2

### Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

### Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Pebble Stitch – refer to pattern for instructions

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### Pebble Stitch Dress

- R1. Ch 46, Ch 1, turn,  
R2-8. Sc into ch 1 from previous row, sc 44, ch 1, turn – 45 sc  
R9. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc  
R10. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc  
R11. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

### Forming armholes

- R12. Sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 6, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, ch 6, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc – 28 sc  
R13. Sc in each sc - 28 sc or

*For collar. Can be done in main colour or contrast colour*

- R13. ch sc 12, 5 dc in next stitch, sc in next stitch, 5 dc in next stitch, sc 13 – 28 sc

Sl st 1 row contrast colour pebble stitch, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next sc and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next sc) repeat to end join round – 45 sc

1 row sc in main colour – 45 sc

*Dress now worked in continuous rounds if doing in one colour. If working in stripes work in rounds by joining each*

### Skirt flared base

- R1. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 in next sc) – 54 sc  
R2. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 in next sc) – 63 sc  
R3. Sc in each of next sc - 63 sc  
R4. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 in next sc) – 72 sc  
R5-7. Sc in each of next sc - 72 sc

R8. Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next sc and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next sc) repeat to end

### Finish armhole edges



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- R1. Pick up from inside piece – 12 sc evenly across entire arm opening – do in main colour or contrast colour, fasten off

### Back edge opening

- R1. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 6sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole), pick up 7 sc. Continuing up left neck edge pick up 12 sc on next side (2 buttonholes on 1 side)

*Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons*

### Pull Up Boots

- R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc
- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc
- R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc
- R11. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc
- R12-16. Sc in each sc – 19 sc

### Boot Edge

- R1. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each front loop – 30 sc

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*Fasten off, weave in ends, decorate with bow or button, or leave as is.*

### Headband

- R1. In main colour ch 45, sl st together being careful not to twist ch
- R2. Hdc in each ch – 45 hdc
- R3. In contrast colour, sc in each hdc – 45 sc
- R4. In main colour, hdc in each sc – 45 hdc

*Fasten off, weave in ends*
