Wardrobe – Collar Top with Shorts



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project

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- Please do not sell this pattern or infer it as your own.
- You may use this pattern to sell any items you complete. Please refer to Gumnut Crochet as the designer.

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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Collar Top, in main colour

- R1. Ch 47, turn,
- R2-4. Hdc into second chain from hook, hdc 44, ch 2, turn – 45 hdc
- R5. (Hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc dec), ch 2, turn– 36 hdc
- R6. (Hdc in each of next 4 hdc, hdc dec) , ch 2, turn – 30 hdc
- R7. (Hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc dec), turn – 24 hdc

Forming armholes

- R8. Ch 2, sc in each of next 4 hdc, ch 8, skip 4 hdc, sc in each of next 8 hdc, ch 8, skip 4 hdc, sc in each of next 4 hdc, ch 1, turn– 32 sc
- R9. Ch1, sc in each sc - 32 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Forming collar

- R10. In main colour, sl st into front loop from R9, ch 2, hdc, ch 1, hdc 2, (hdc 2, ch 1, hdc 2) repeat to end
- R11. Sl st into ch gap from first shell in previous row, ch 2, hdc, ch 1, hdc 2 (in next ch 1 gap hdc 2, ch 1, hdc 2) repeat to end
- R12. In contrast colour, (4 ch, sc into ch 1, 4 ch, sc into gap between shells) – repeat to end
- R13. In contrast colour, sl st into back loop from R9, sc each sc
- R14. (4 ch, sc into every sc) – picot edge

Fasten off, weave in ends

- R15. In contrast colour, sl st into first st in row, ch 2, hdc, ch 1, hdc 2, (hdc 2, ch 1, hdc 2)

Fasten off, weave in ends

Back Opening

- R1. In main colour, sl st into first st on right neck edge, ch 4 (buttonhole), sl st back to same st, pick up and sc 4 stitches evenly along edge ch 4 (buttonhole), continue to pick up and sc stitches evenly to base. Repeat on other side without making buttonholes.

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Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on buttons

Pants

First Leg -

- R1. Ch 31, join with slip stitch, being careful not to twist chain, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each ch, sl st, ch 1 – 30 ch
- R2-4. (Ch 4, skip 4, sc in next 2 sc), sl st, repeat
- R5. (Sc 2, ch 2, yarn over, pass hook under all 3 chain rows, yarn over, pull through, ch 2, sc in each of next 2 sc) repeat
- R6. (Ch 4, skip 4, sc in next 2 sc), sl st, ch 1, repeat
- R7. Sc in each sc, sl st, ch 1 – 30 sc
- R8. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc dec), sl st, ch 2 – 25sc
- R9-11. Hdc in each hdc, sl st, ch 2 - 25 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Second leg -

Complete same as first leg but do not fasten off

- R12. Sl st to join to second leg, ch 2, hdc 24 around second leg, sl st to join again to first leg, hdc 23 – 50 hdc

Working in rounds ie sl st to join round, ch 2

- R13-17. Hdc in each of next hdc, sl st, ch 2 – 50 hdc
- R18. (Hdc in each of next 8 hdc, hdc dec) sl st, ch 2 – 45 hdc
- R19. (Hdc in each of next 7 hdc, hdc dec) sl st, ch 2, – 40 hdc
- R20. (Hdc in each of next 6 hdc, hdc dec), sl st, ch 2 – 35 hdc
- R21. Hdc in each hdc – 35 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Headband



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- R1. Ch 47, sl st to join being careful not to twist chain.
- R2. Hdc in second chain from hook, hdc remaining chain – 45 hdc

Sandals slip on – Make 2

- R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc
- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc
- R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc
- R9. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends. Place bow or button on toe or side to decorate
