Wardrobe – Coloured Hoodie

This is designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project

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- Please do not sell this pattern or infer it as your own.
- You may use this pattern to sell any items you complete. Please refer to Gumnut Crochet as the designer.

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Dc – double crochet

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Hoodie – In Green worked in rows starting from the waist

In main colour

- R1. Ch 50
- R2. hdc in third chain from hook, hdc in each of next 47 ch, turn – 48 hdc
- R3-6. Ch 2, hdc in every hdc, turn – 48 hdc
- R7. Ch 2, (hdc 4, dec) turn – 40 hdc
- R8. Ch 2, hdc 6, dec (hdc 3, dec) x 5, hdc 7, turn – 34 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Shaping for sleeve openings – in red

- R9-10 Ch2, hdc 6, turn – 6 hdc
- R11. Ch2, hdc 4, dec, turn – 5 hdc
- R12. Ch 2, hdc 3, dec, – 4 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Repeat 9-12 for other side. Start 6 st in from edge

Shaping for back – in red

- R13. Insert hook into 4th stitch from R12. where shaping for front commenced, hdc in next 15 hdc, turn – 15 hdc
- R14. Ch 2, hdc in each hdc, turn – 15 hdc
- R15. Ch 2, (hdc in next 3 hdc, dec), turn – 12 hdc
- R16. C21, hdc 4, dec - 10 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Joining both front shoulder and back shoulder pieces together purple

- R17. Sl st into 1 sc at top of front piece, sc 4 across the top of the first front, 4 ch (to finish first sleeve opening), sc 10 across the top of the back, 4 ch (to finish second sleeve opening), sc 5 from across other front, turn – 26 sc, turn



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- R18. Ch 2, hdc 26, turn – 26 hdc
- R19. Ch 2, hdc 5, inc (hdc 4, inc) x 3, hdc 5, turn – 30 hdc
- R20. Ch 2, (hdc 4, inc) x 5, hdc 5, turn – 35 hdc
- R21. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 35 sc
- R22. Ch 3, dc in each sc, turn – 35 dc
- R23. Repeat R21 - 35 sc
- R24. Repeat R22 - 35 dc
- R25. Repeat R21 – 35 sc
- R26. Repeat R22 – 35 dc
- R27. Repeat R21 – 35 sc
- R28. Repeat R22 – 35 dc
- R29-30. Ch1, sc in each stitch, turn - 35 sc
- R31. Ch 1, sc 4, dec (sc 3, dec) to last 4 sc, sc 4, turn– 29 sc
- R32. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 29 sc
- R33. Ch 1, sc 12, dec, sc, dec, sc 12, turn – 27 sc
- R34. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn - 27 sc
- R35. Ch 1, sc 10 (dec) x 3, sc 11, turn – 24 sc
- R36. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 24 sc
- R37. Ch 1, sc 9, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 9, turn– 22 sc
- R38. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn- 22 sc
- R39. Ch 1, sc 8 (dec) x 3, sc 8, turn – 19 sc
- R40. Ch 1, sc 6 (dec) x 3, sc 7 – 16 sc



Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew top of hood together. Fold hood in half. Sew the edges together or crochet together with slip stitch.

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Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew top of hood together. Fold hood in half. Sew the edges together or crochet together with slip stitch.

Sleeve – worked in round – in blue

R1. Sl st into any stitch on arm opening edge, sc 25 evenly around armhole edge, sl st tog, – 5, 8, 4, 8 – 25 sc

R2-3. Ch 2, in back loops, hdc in each st, sl st tog – 25 hdc

R4-5. Ch 2, hdc in each hdc, sl st tog – 25 hdc

R6-7. Ch 2, in back loops, hdc in each st, sl st tog – 25 hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

For short sleeves, only complete the number of rows from R2-7 needed to achieve the desired length.

To finish front and hood edges and make buttonholes

R1. Sl st into bottom stitch around edge, picking up stitches evenly along front edges and hood, sc in each stitch, with 4 ch for each buttonhole, ch 1, turn

R2. Sc in each sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on buttons

Shorts

First Leg

R1. Ch 25, join with slip stitch, being careful not to twist chain, ch 1

R2-11. Sc in each sc, st, ch 1 - 25 sc

Fasten off,

Second leg. Same as first leg but do not fasten off

R12. Sc to join to second leg, sc 24 around second leg, sc to join again to first leg, sc 23 – 50 sc

R13-26. Working in continuous rounds, sc in each of next sc – 50 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Scrunch Boots

R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc

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- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc
- R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc
- R11. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc
- R12-16. Sc in each sc – 19 sc short boots
- R17. 2 sc in each sc, roll down edge – 38 sc
- R18. 2 sc in each sc – 76 sc

Boot Edge

- R1. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each front loop – 30 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, decorate with bow or button, or leave as is.
