Wardrobe – Large Shell Stitch Dress

Designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

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- Please do not sell this pattern or infer it as your own.

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- V st – 2 double crochet, 1 ch, 2 double crochet in same stitch
- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase



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Large Shell Pattern, Worked in rows from waist up

- R1. Ch 38, turn,
R2. Hdc into third chain from hook, hdc 35, ch 2, turn – 36 hdc
R3. Hdc in each hdc, ch 2, turn - 36 hdc
R4. (Hdc in each of next 4 hdc, hdc dec), ch 2, turn – 30 hdc
R5. Hdc in each of next hdc, ch 2, turn – 30 hdc
R6. (Hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc dec), ch 2, turn – 24 hdc

Forming armholes

- R7. Sc in each of next 4 hdc, ch 6, skip 4 hdc, sc in each of next 7 hdc, ch 6, skip 4 hdc, sc in each of next 4 hdc, sl st, ch 1, turn – 28 sc
R8. Sc in each sc – 28 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Skirt Flared Base with Large Shell Pattern

- R9. Sl st into any stitch from R1 and sc in each loop, ch 2, turn – 36 sc
R10. In back loops, (hdc in each of next 3 sc, 2 hdc in next sc), sl st to join into round, ch 2 – 45 hdc
R11. (hdc in each of next 4 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc), sl st, ch 2 – 54 hdc
R12. (hdc in each of next 5 hdc, hdc 2 in next hdc), sl st, ch 2 – 63 hdc
R13. In back loops (hdc in each of next 6 hdc, hdc 2 in next hdc), sl st, ch 2 – 72 hdc
R14. Hdc in each of next hdc, sl st, ch 2 - 72 hdc
R15. Hdc in each hdc, sl st, ch 2 – 72 hdc

Shell Edging

- R16. In any front loop from R10, R13 and R15, sl st, ch 1, skip 2, (9 dc in one loop, skip 3, v st in next loop, skip 3), to end, sc last, sl st



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R17. If you start with a v st as the first st, sl st to centre of first v st, (ch 2, dc, ch 1, dc x 2) in first v st, (v st st in each v st, dc, ch 1, in each dc)

If the row starts with a 9 dc cluster, ch 3, (dc in next dc, ch)

Fasten off, weave in ends

Sleeve edges

R1. Sl st into inside edge of shoulder gap – skip 3, ch 2, (8 dc into same st, sk 3, sl st) to end,

R2. Ch 3, (dc into dc, ch 1, dc into dc) sl st to end,

Fasten off, weave in ends

Back edge opening

R1. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 6sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole), pick up 7 sc. Continuing up left neck edge pick up 12 sc on next side (2 buttonholes on 1 side)

Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons

Headband

R1. In main colour, ch 45, sl st to round, being careful not to twist chain, ch 2

R2. Hdc in each hdc – 45 hdc

R3. In contrast colour, hdc in each hdc – 45 hdc

R4. In main colour, hdc in each hdc – 45 hdc

Fasten off, sew in ends

Shoes – Make 2

R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc

R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc

R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc

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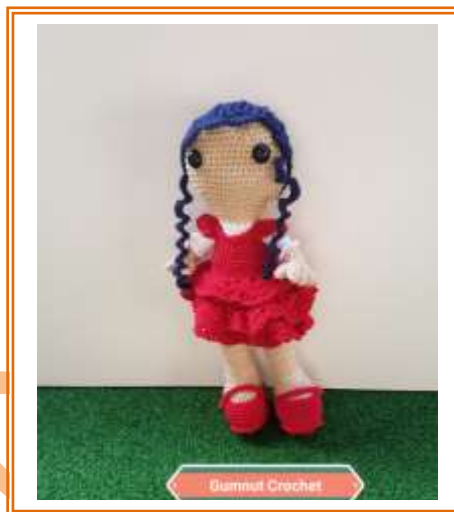
R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc

R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc

R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc

R11. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc



Fasten off, weave in ends. Place bow or button on toe or side to decorate
