Wardrobe – One Piece Overalls with Hood



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

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- Please do not sell this pattern or infer it as your own.
- You may use this pattern to sell any items you complete. Please refer to Gumnut Crochet as the designer.

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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Overalls with Hoodie –

First Leg-

- R1. In contrast colour, ch 25, join with slip stitch, being careful not to twist chain, ch 2
- R2. Dc in each ch – 24 dc

Fasten off

- R3-7. In main colour, ch 2, hdc in each hdc, skip each ch spaces, - 24 hdc

Fasten off

Second leg. Complete same as first leg but do not fasten off

- R8. Sl st to join to second leg, ch 2, hdc 22 around second leg, hdc to join again to first leg, hdc 23 – 48 hdc

Working in rounds ie sl st to join round, ch 2

- R9-14. Hdc in each of next hdc, sl st, ch 2, turn - 48 hdc

Separate for front opening

- R15. Ch 1, sc 8, dec (sc 3, dec) x 6, sc 8, turn – 41 sc Ch 1,
- R16. Ch 1, sc 19, dec, sc 20, turn – 40 sc
- R17. Ch 1, sc 6, dec (sc 3, dec) x 5, sc 7, turn – 34 sc
- R18. Ch 1, sc 34, turn – 34 sc

Shaping for sleeve openings

- R19-21. Ch1, sc 6, turn – 6 sc
- R22. Ch 1, sc 4, dec, turn – 5 sc
- R16. Ch 1, sc 5, turn – 5 sc
- R17. Ch 1, sc 3, dec, turn – 4 sc
- R18. Ch1, sc 4 – 4 sc

Variation: 2 rows of first contrast colour, 2 rows of second contrast colour

For shorts, fasten off at R4, commence R8.



Variation: Rd 16 – contrast colour x 3 rows sc

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Fasten off, weave in ends

Repeat 12-18 for other side. There is no need to reverse stitches, just complete as per first side.

Shaping for back

R19. Insert hook into 4th stitch from R12. where shaping for front commenced, sc in next 15 sc, turn – 15 sc

R20-22. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 15 sc

R23. Ch 1, (sc in next 3 sc, dec) x 3, turn – 12 sc

R24. Ch1, sc 12, turn – 12 sc

R25. Ch1, (sc 4, dec) x 2, turn - 10 sc

R26. Ch 1, sc 10, – 10 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Joining both front shoulder and back shoulder pieces together

R27. Sl st into 1 sc at top of front piece, sc 4 across the top of the first front, 4 ch (to finish first sleeve opening), sc 10 across the top of the back, 4 ch (to finish second sleeve opening), sc 4 from across other front, turn – 26 sc, turn

R28-29. Ch 1, sc 26, turn – 26 sc

R30. Ch 1, sc 5, inc (sc 4, inc) x 3, sc 5, turn – 30 sc

R31. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 30 sc

R32. Ch 1, (sc 4, inc) x 5, sc 5, turn – 35 sc

R33. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 35 sc

R34. Ch 3, dc in each sc, turn – 35 dc

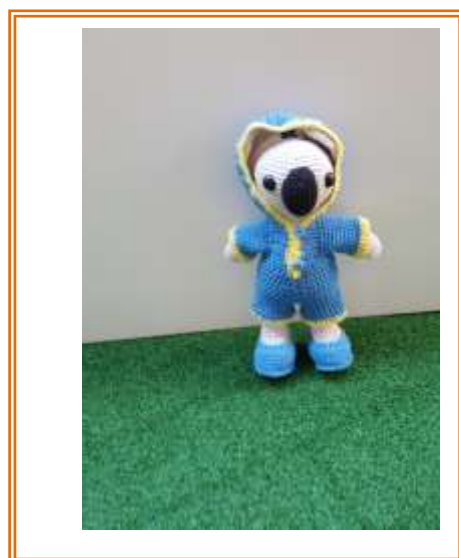
R35. Repeat R33 - 35 sc

R36. Repeat R34 - 35 dc

R37. Repeat R33 – 35 sc

R38. Repeat R34 – 35 dc

R39. Repeat R33 – 35 sc



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R40. Repeat R34 – 35 dc

R41-42. Ch1, sc in each stitch, turn - 35 sc

R43. Ch 1, sc 4, dec (sc 3, dec) x 5, sc 4, turn– 29 sc

R44. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 29 sc

R45. Ch 1, sc 12, dec, sc, dec, sc 12, turn – 27 sc

R46. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn - 27 sc

R47. Ch 1, sc 10 (dec) x 3, sc 11, turn – 24 sc

R48. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn – 24 sc

R49. Ch 1, sc 9, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 9, turn– 22 sc

R50. Ch 1, sc in each sc, turn- 22 sc

R51. Ch 1, sc 8 (dec) x 3, sc 8, turn – 19 sc

R52. Ch 1, sc 6 (dec) x 3, sc 7, turn – 16 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew top of hood together. Fold hood in half. Sew the edges together or crochet together with slip stitch.

Sleeve – worked in round

R1. Sl st into any stitch on arm opening edge, sc 25 evenly around armhole edge, sl st tog, – 5, 8, 4, 8 – 25 sc

R2-10. Ch 1, sc into each sc, sl st tog, – 25 sc

Fasten off

R11. In contrast colour, Ch 2, dc in to each sc, sl st tog - 25 dc

Fasten off, weave in ends

To finish front and hood edges and make buttonholes – right side for buttonholes

R1. Sl st into bottom stitch around edge, picking up stitches evenly along front edges and hood, sc in each stitch, with 4 ch for each buttonhole on right side of front, ch 1, turn

R2. Sc in each sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on buttons

For short sleeves, only complete the number of rows from R2-13 needed to achieve the desired length.

Variation: do edging in contrast colour
