Wardrobe – Pebble Stitch Dress

Designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons x 6

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

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- Please do not sell this pattern or infer it as your own.
- You may use this pattern to sell any items you complete. Please refer to Gumnut Crochet as the designer.

Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Special stitch pebble stitch refer to pattern for instructions

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Pebble stitch dress

- R1. Ch 26, turn,
- R2. Hdc into third chain from hook – hdc rest, ch 2, turn – 24 hdc
- R3. (Hdc in next 3 hdc, hdc inc) – 30 hdc
- R4. (Hdc in next 4 hdc, hdc inc) ch 2, turn – 36 hdc
- R5. Hdc in each hdc, ch 2, turn – 36 hdc
- R6. (Hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc inc), ch 2, turn – 45 hdc
- R7. (hdc in each of next 4 hdc, hdc inc) – 54 hdc
- R8. Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next st and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next st) repeat to end
- R9. In main colour (hdc in each of next 5 st, sc 2 in next st) – 63
- R10. Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next st and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next st) repeat to end
- R11. In main colour, (hdc in each of next 6 st, sc 2 in next st), sl st tog to form round – 72
- R12. Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next st and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next st) repeat to end
- R13. In main colour hdc in each st - 72 hdc
- R14. Turn Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next st and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc n next st) repeat to end

Forming armholes

- R1. Sl st into first stitch from R1, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 1, turn– 32 sc
- R2. Sc in each sc - 32 sc, fasten off, weave in ends

Finish armhole edges



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- R1. Pick up from inside edge of armhole, – Pebble stitch contrast colour, ((yarn over, insert hook into the next sc and draw up 1 loop) x 3, yarn over and draw though all 7 loops on the hook, 1 sc in next sc) repeat to end

Fasten off, weave in ends

Back edge opening

- R1. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 6sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole). Continuing to pick up stitches down right edge and up left back edge (2 buttonholes on right side)

Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons

Headband

- R1. Ch 45, sl st together being careful not to twist chain
R2. sc in each ch – 45 sc
R3. Ch 2, hdc, ch 2, hdc in first sc, ((2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc, ch 1) in next stitch)-

Fasten off, weave in ends

Sandals – Make 2

- R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc
- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc



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R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc

R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc

R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc

R11. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc

Forming Bands

R1. Sl st into chain where you would like the band to start, ch 14, turn, sc in 4th chain from hook (buttonhole), sc in each ch, sl st to sandal.

Repeat for other sandal. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Finishing Sole Edge

R1. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each front loop – 30 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on button. Repeat for other sandal.
