

# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



- You may use this pattern to sell any items you complete. Please refer to Gumnut Crochet as the designer.

**Wardrobe – Girls Ribbed Dress – designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll**



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons x 2

### Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

### Copyright

### Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase



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### Ribbed Dress – Worked sideways for skirt

- R1. Ch 16, turn  
R2. Sc into second chain from hook, sc 15, ch1, turn  
R3-47 Sc back loops each sc, ch1, turn – 15 sc

*Fasten off if changing colour for top of dress, weave in ends.*

- R48. In yoke colour, pick up 45 st across top, sc in each ch 2, turn – 45 sc  
R49. Sc in each sc, ch 1, turn – 45 sc  
R50. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog), ch 1, turn – 40 sc  
R51. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog), ch 1, turn – 32 sc  
R52. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog), ch 1, turn – 24 sc  
R53. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

### Shaping for armholes

- R54. Sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, ch 8, skip 4 sc, sc in each of last 4 sc – 32 sc  
R55. Sc in each sc – 32 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends. Sew back edge opening closed leaving gap big enough for doll to fit*

### Back edge opening

- R1. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 4 sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole). Continue to pick up sc evenly down right edge, continuing up left neck edge (2 buttonholes on right side)

*Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons*

### Headband - Change colour every 2 rows from R4.

- R1. Ch 45, sl st tog being careful not to twist chain, ch 1  
R2. Sc in each ch, sl st tog, ch 1 – 45 sc

*Variation: change colour every row from R3-47.*



*Variation: change colour every row from R3-7.*

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R3-7. Sc in each bl, sl st tog, ch 1 – 45 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends*

### Sandels – Make 2

R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc

R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc

R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc

R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc

R6-9. sc in each sc – 30 sc

R10. In bl sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, turn, ch 1

R11-18 Sc in each sc, sl st to close

*Fasten off, weave in ends*

R19. Sl st into top of shoe where the band will start. Ch 15, sl st into 5 chain from hook (buttonhole), sc in each ch, sl st to close.

*Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on button*



*Variation: Change colour for R6*
