

# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



**Wardrobe – Wattle Stitch Dress. Designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Gumnut Crochet Doll**



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity - contrast
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

### Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

### Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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### Wattle Stitch Dress (worked in rounds from base to top)

- R1. In main colour, ch 72, in third chain from hook, \* (1sc, 1 ch, 1 dc) skip 2 ch, \* repeat from \* to \*to end, 1 sc in last chain, turn
- Rd 2. In contrast colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R3. In main colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R4. In contrast colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R5. In main colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R6. In contrast colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn, fasten off contrast colour
- R7. In main colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R8. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 63 sc
- R9. Ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R10. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 54
- R11. Ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R12. Ch 1, (Sc in each of next 3 st, sc dec )
- R13. In contrast colour, (sc in each of next 2 st, sc 2 tog)
- R14. In contrast colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R15.16. In main colour, ch 1, skip 2 \*(1sc, 1ch, 1dc) in the next ch sp, skip 2\*, repeat to end, 1 sc in last ch, turn
- R17. Sc in each – 34 sc

### Forming armholes

- R18. Sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 6, skip 6 sc, sc in each of next 10 sc, ch 6, skip 6 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc– 34 sc
- R19. Sc in each sc - 34 sc



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### Back edge opening

- R1. Sew up back seam leaving enough room for button hole opening to fit comfortably on doll. On right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 4 sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole). Continue to pick up sc evenly down right edge, continuing up left neck edge (2 buttonholes on right side)

*Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons*

### Sleeve Edge

- R1. In contrast colour, sl st into bottom edge of sleeve, ch 1, (2 sc, ch 1, skip 1) sl st to close

*Fasten off, weave in ends*

### Headband

- R1. In main colour, ch 45, join with sl st being careful not to twist chain, ch 2,

- R2-4. Hdc in each ch, sl st - 45 hdc

*Fasten off, weave in end, sew on button*

### Pull Up Boots

- R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc

- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc

- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc

- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

- R5. Sc in each back loops - 30 sc

- R6-9. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

- R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc



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R11. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc

R12-16. Sc in each sc – 19 sc

### Boot Edge

R19. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each loop – 30 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends, decorate with button or bow, or leave as is*

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
