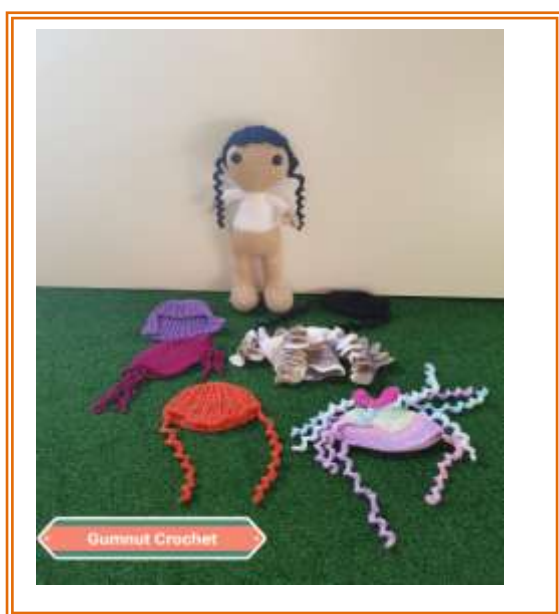

Gumnut Crochet Doll

Clothes are listed on my blog page and are all free patterns. There are several wigs, that can be sewn on as permanent hair.

There are lots of clothes patterns – dresses, tops, overalls hoodies, skirts, shoes, vests and pants.



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram for head, body, arms, legs and ears
- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram for shirt
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 15 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2

Size – 26 cms

Skill Level

- Intermediate

- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar
- Joining the legs and making the hands are the most difficult parts of this doll. A variation which enables the legs to be sewn on, rather than crocheted together is included, as is a simpler version of hands.

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.
- 8 ply cotton makes size about 35 cm in height

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

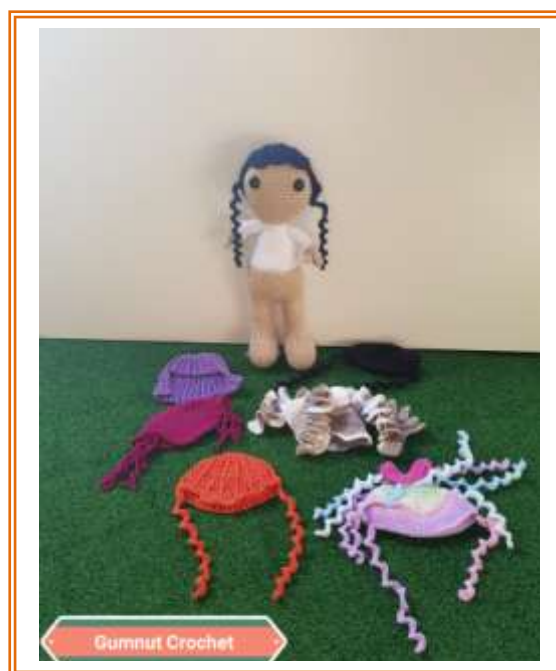
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Feet and Legs - Make 2

- R1. In main colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc
- R2. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R5. Sc in each back loop onl – 30 sc
- R6-7. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R8. Sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc
- R9. sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc
- Rd10. Sc in each of next 5 sc (sc2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 6 sc – 15 sc
- Rd11-21. sc each sc – 15 sc



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Fasten off, leaving a long tail on one leg to use to sew the gap between the legs together once joined, Fill lightly, place markers at centre middle of both legs, to mark where the legs will be joined. Legs are joined at the middle centre of each inside leg, with 3 chain between each inner leg

Body

R22. Slip stitch into centre inside side of first leg, chain 3 join to the second leg at inside centre, sc in each of next 14 sc around second leg, ch 3, sc in each of next 13 sc around first leg – 36 sc

Check that legs are aligned, before proceeding. If you would prefer to sew the legs to the body, finish the legs to R21 and then follow these rows before commencing R23. Skip R22 completely for this version:

- *Ch2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 sc – 6sc*
- *2 sc in each sc – 12 sc*
- *(Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc*
- *(sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc*
- *(sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc*
- *(sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc)– 36 sc*

R23. Sc in each sc – 36 sc

R24. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R25. (sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R26-29. sc in each sc - 48 sc

R30. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R31-32. sc in each sc - 42 sc

R33. (sc in each of next 5, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc



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Change to shirt colour

R34-35. sc in each sc - 36 sc

R36. (sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R37-38. sc in each sc - 30 sc

R39. (sc in each of next 8 sc, sc 2 tog) – 27 sc

R40-41. sc in each sc - 27 sc

R42. (sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R43. sc in each sc - 24 sc

R44. (sc in each of next 6, sc 2 tog) – 21 sc

R45. sc in each sc - 21 sc

R46. (sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

Sew gap between legs. Fill without stretching stitches

Change to head colour

Neck

R47. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

Head

R48. (sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R49. (sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R50. (sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R51. (sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R52. (sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc



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R53. (sc in each of next 7 sc , 2 sc in next sc) – 54

R54 – R60. sc in each sc - 54 sc

Insert or embroider eyes 8 - 10 sc apart, in round 57

R61. (sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 48 sc

R62. (sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R63. (sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R64. (sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

Fill neck firmly

R65. (sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R66. (sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R67. (sc in next 1 sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R68. (sc 2 tog) – 6 sc



Fill head, fasten off and thread through remaining sc to close gap.

Arms x 2 – in head colour

R1. Ch 2, sc 6 into second chain from hook, or magic circle 6, sl st to close – 6 sc

R2. (2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc

R3. (sc in next 1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18sc

R4-5. sc in each sc - 18sc

R6. (1 sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

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R7. Sc in each sc - 12 sc

R8. *For long sleeves for the boy change colour to shirt colour. Sc in back loops only for this row.*

For short sleeves for girl sc in each sc as normal – 12 sc

R9-10. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R11. (sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 8 sc

For girl or short sleeves change to shirt colour

R12. In back loops, sc in each sc – 8 sc

R13-18. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Fill without stretching stitches

R19. (sc 2 tog) x 2, sc in each of next 4 sc

Fasten off leaving tail to sew arm to body.

Hand with thumb and Arm (Make 2) – with beige yarn (simpler version of hands than making 5 fingers)

Thumb

R1. Ch 2, sc 4 in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 – 4sc

R2-3. Sc in each sc – 4 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew up any holes left in work

Hand

R1. Ch 4, in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of chain, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 10 sc

R2-3. Sc in each sc - 10 sc

R4. Sc thumb to hand, sc around thumb, sc 8 – 14 sc

R5. Sc in each sc - sc 14

R6. Sc in each of next 2 sc, (sc dec, sc in each of next 1 sc) – 10 sc



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R7. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc dec – sc 8

R8. Sc in each sc - 8 sc

R9. Ch 2, hdc in front loops only – 8 hdc

Fasten off, fill lightly

R10. Change to white yarn, fold down front loops and in back

loops sc in each loop – 8 sc

R11-18. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Fill lightly,

R19. (sc 2 tog) x2, sc 4 – 6 sc

R20. (sc 2 tog) x 2, sc 2 – 4 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew arm to body

Hand with 5 fingers and arm x 2

Starting with shoulder and with a long tail to enable you to sew the arm to the body

R1. In white, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (sc in next 1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 9 sc

R3-11. Sc in each sc – 9 sc

R12. In front loops, 2 sc in each sc – 9 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

R13. In back loops with hand colour, (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 12 sc

R14-15. Sc in each sc – 12 sc



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R16. (sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc

First finger

R1. 1 sc across to other side of work, which is into the 5th st from the hook, counting backwards. – 5 sc

R2-4. Sc in each sc – 5sc, sl st across top to close top of finger

Fasten off, weave in ends

Second and third finger

R1. Sl st into next sc in hand next to finger just completed. Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 ch, sc into second sc back from previous finger - 6 sc

R2-4. Sc in each sc – 6 sc, sl st across top to close top of finger

Fasten off, weave in ends, fill arm and fingers lightly

Fourth finger

R1. Sl st into next sc in hand next to finger just completed. Sc across remaining sc, ch across finger to join – 5 sc

R2-4. Sc in each sc, - 5 sc, sl st across top to close top of finger.

Fasten off, weave in ends

Thumb

R1. Ch 2, 5 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 5 sc – 5 sc

R2-3. Sc in each sc – 5 sc, sl st across top to close top of finger

Fasten off, fill lightly, weave in ends, sew to hand.
