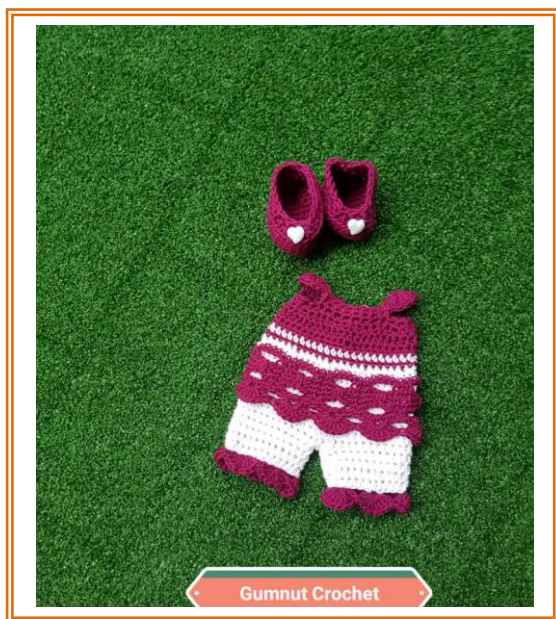


# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



**Wardrobe – Overalls with Butterfly Stitch Overskirt.**  
Designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Doll and Gumnut Crochet Koala



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram – contrast colour
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker x 1
- Buttons

### Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

### Gauge

- Gauge is critical to this project if making the piece to match the dolls designed by Gumnut Crochet.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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### Overalls – with Butterfly Stitch Overskirt. Worked from legs to neck

#### *First Leg-*

- R1. In white, ch 25, join with slip stitch, being careful not to twist chain, ch 2
- R2. Hdc in each ch, sl st to join, ch 2 – 25 hdc
- R3-5. Ch 2, hdc in each hdc, sl st to join, ch 2 – 25 hdc

*For shorts, do 2 rows less*

*Fasten off,*

*Second leg. Complete same as first leg but do not fasten off*

- R6. Sl st to join to second leg, hdc 24 around second leg, sl st to join again to first leg, hdc 23 – 50 hdc

*Working in continuous rounds ie sl st to join round, ch 2*

- R7. Hdc in each of next hdc, sl st, ch 2 – 50 hdc
- R8-15. Hdc in each of next hdc, sl st, ch 2 – 50 hdc
- R16. In back loops (Hdc in each of next 8 hdc, hdc dec) – 45 hdc

Separate for back opening,

- R17-18. Turn, ch 1, sc in each st – 45 sc
- R19. In mauve, turn ch1, (sc in each of next 3 hdc, sc dec) – 36 sc
- R20. In white, turn, ch 1, sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R21. In mauve, turn, ch 1, sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R22. Turn, ch 2, (Hdc in each of next 2 hdc, hdc dec) – 27 hdc
- R23. Turn, ch 2, Hdc in each hdc – 27 hdc

*Forming Arm Openings*

- R1. In mauve, sc in each of next 5 hdc, ch 8, skip 4 hdc, sc in each of next 9 hdc, ch 8, skip 5 hdc, sc in each of next 4 hdc, ch 1, turn – 32 sc



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R2. Ch 1, sc in each sc – 32 sc

### Back edge opening

R1. In mauve, on right neck edge pick up 1 sc, chain 4 (for first buttonhole), sc back into base sc, pick up 4 sc, chain 4 (for second buttonhole). Continue to pick up sc evenly down right edge, continuing up left neck edge (2 buttonholes on right side)

*Fasten off, sew in ends – sew on buttons*

### Leg edge

R1. In mauve, sl st into any foundation loop from R1 leg, ch 3, 7 dc into same loop, (skip 4, 8 dc into same loop), sl st to join – 5 dc shells

*Fasten off, weave in ends. Repeat for second leg.*

### Arm edge

R1. In mauve, sl st into bottom corner of sleeve opening, ch 3, skip 3, 7 dc into same loop, skip 3, sl st to close – 1 dc shell

*Fasten off, weave in ends. Repeat for second arm.*

### Butterfly Stitch Overskirt

R1. In mauve, sl st into first front loop from R16, sc in each front loop

R2-4. (Ch 4, skip 4, sc 2), repeat to end of row

R5. Sc 2, ch 2, (yarn over, pass hook under all 3 chain rows, yarn over, pull through, ch 2, sc 2) – repeat to end of row

R6. (Ch 4, skip 4, sc 2), repeat to end of row

R7. Sc in each ch and sc

R8. 8 double crochet in middle of each 4 chain or hole from previous row

*Fasten off weave in ends*
