Table Top Christmas Tree Decoration



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – dark green or light green
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity red, blue, brown, white
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 16 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2
- Purchased bells or beads

Size

- 22 cm in height

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Dc – double crochet
- Dc dec – double crochet decrease

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Christmas Tree – worked in continuous rounds, starting with base

- R1. In main colour, magic circle 6, or ch 2, sc 6 in second chain from hook
- R2. (2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc
- R3. (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R4. (sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R5. (sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R6. (sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc
- R7. (sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc
- R8. (sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc
- R9. (sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 54
- R10. (sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 60 sc
- R11. (sc in each of next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc), sl st to close round if making colour change here – 66 sc

Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each row. It avoids having to count each multiple as well as each stitch.

If making colour change, fasten off old colour, change to new colour, ch 1 and sc in same ch space

- R12. in back loops only, sc in each sc – 66 sc

Base completed, forming sides of tree

- R13. Sc in each sc – 66 sc
- R14. (Sc in each of next 20 sc, sc dec) – 63 sc
- R15. Sc in each sc – 63 sc

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R16. (sc in each of next 19 sc, sc dec) – 60 sc

R17. Sc in each sc – 60 sc

R18. (sc in each of next 18 sc, sc dec) – 57 sc

R19. Sc in each sc – 57 sc

R20. (sc in each of next 17 sc, sc dec), if making colour change, sl st to close round – 54 sc

If making colour change, fasten off old colour, change to new colour, ch 1 and sc in same ch 1 space

R21. In back loops, sc in each sc – 54 sc

R22. (sc in each of next 16 sc, sc dec) – 51 sc

R23. Sc in each sc – 51 sc

R24. (sc in each of next 15 sc, sc dec) – 48 sc

R25. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

R26. (sc in each of next 14 sc, sc dec) – 45 sc

R27. Sc in each sc – 45 sc

R28. (sc in each of next 13 sc, sc dec) – 42 sc

R29. Sc in each sc – 42 sc

R30. (sc in each of next 12 sc, sc dec) if changing colour sl st to close round – 39 sc

If making colour change, fasten off old colour, change to new colour, ch 1 and sc in same ch 1 space

- R31. In back loops sc in each sc – 39 sc
- R32. (sc in each of next 11 sc, sc dec) – 36 sc
- R33. Sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R34. (sc in each of next 10 sc, sc dec) – 33 sc
- R35. Sc in each sc – 33 sc
- R36. (sc in each of next 9 sc, sc dec) – 30 sc
- R37. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R38. (sc in each of next 8 sc, sc dec) – 27 sc
- R39. Sc in each sc – 27 sc
- R40. (sc in each of next 7 sc, sc dec) – 24 sc
- R41. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R42. (sc in each of next 6 sc, sc dec) – 21 sc
- Insert Eyes – 8 sc apart*
- R43. Sc in each sc – 21 sc
- R44. (sc in each of next 5 sc, sc dec) – 18 sc



Gumnut Crochet

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- R45. Sc in each sc – 18 sc
- R46. (sc in each of next 4 sc, sc dec) – 15 sc
- R47. Sc in each sc – 15 sc
- R48. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc dec) – 12 sc
- R49. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R50. (sc in each of next 2 sc, sc dec) – 9 sc
- R51. (sc in each sc, sc dec) – 6 sc
- R51. Fasten off, close, gap, weave in ends

Tree Edging

- R1. Holding piece upside down, sl st into any front loop from R R R
. Ch 2, 7 dc in same st, (skip 2, 8 dc in next st) – repeat to end

Fasten off, weave in ends

Nose – in red

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2. (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc
- R3. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R4. (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc



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R5. Sc in each sc – 10 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew nose to tree. Weave in ends.

Mitten and Arm (Make 2)

Thumb

Rd1. Ch 2, 4 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 sc – 4 sc

Rd2. Sc in each sc – 4 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail

Glove

Rd1. Ch 4, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 10 sc

Rd2-3. Sc in each sc – 10 sc

Joining Thumb to Glove

Rd4. Sc thumb to glove, sc 4 sc around thumb, join to glove again with sc, sc around glove – 14 sc

Rd5. Sc in each sc - 14 sc

Rd6. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

Rd7. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – sc 8

Rd8. Sc in each sc - 8 sc

Fasten off white, in arm colour,

Rd10. In back loops, sc in each sc – 8 sc

Rd11-21. Sc in each sc - 8 sc

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Fasten off leaving long tail to sew to body. Fill, without stretching stitches, leaving top off arm loosely filled. Sew to body

Boots – make 2 – in red yarn

- R1. Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 18 sc
- R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc
- R3. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc

If changing colour for R6, sl st to close round. Do not fasten off red. Sl st blue yarn, ch 1 and sc into same ch space. At end of R6, sl st to close round, fasten off blue, sl st red yarn, ch 1, sc into same ch space.

- R6-9. Sc in each sc.– 30 sc
- R10. In back loops sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc
- R11. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7sc, sc 2 tog, – 19 sc
- R12-21. Sc in each sc – 19 sc

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew piece to base of tree. Fill lightly, whip stitch edges together, sew to tree

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Boot Edge

R1. Sl st into any front loop from R5, sc in each front loop – 30 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, decorate with bow or button, or leave as is.

Hat

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc

R2. Sc in each sc - 6 sc

R3. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc

R4-5. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

R6. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc

R7-8. Sc in each sc – 10 sc

R9. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 12 sc

R10-12. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R13. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 14 sc

R14-15. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

R16. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 16 sc

R17-18. Sc in each sc – 16 sc

R19. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R20-21 Sc in each sc - 18 sc

R22. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc), sl st to close round for colour change – 24 sc

R23. With contrast yarn, ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in each sc – 24 sc

To put a roll on the edge, complete another 4 row in contrast yarn and roll up.

Pompom – in contrast colour

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in chain or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 8 sc



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R3. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc

R4. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) - 12 sc

R5. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 10 sc

R6. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 8 sc

R7. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

Fill lightly

R8. (Sc 2 tog)

Fasten off, leaving long tail, weave in ends, sew to top of hat

Christmas Stocking

R1. Ch 4, sc second chain from hook, sc in next ch, 3 sc in next ch, turn working in foundation ch, sc in each of next 2 sc, 3 sc in last – 10 sc

R2. Sc in each sc – 10 sc

R3. Sc in next sc, (sc 2 tog) x 2, sc in each of next 5 sc - 8 sc

R4. Sc in next sc, (sc 2 tog) x 2, sc in each of next 3 sc – 6 sc

R5-8. Sc in each sc - 6 sc

In last sc, sl st tog to close round for colour change. Fasten off yarn. In white, ch 1, sc in same ch

R9. In white, sc in each sc – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave in end. Sew to tree. Sew on some balls or bells as desired
