Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.
- 8 ply cotton makes size about 35 cm in height

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity face colour
- Size 3. mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 7.5 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2

Size

- 25 cm in height

Skill Level

- Intermediate

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Body worked in continuous rounds ie – no sl st to end each row

Rd1. Ch 2, 10 sc in second chain or magic circle 10 sc – 10 sc,

Rd2. (sc, inc) x 5 – 15 sc

Rd3. (2sc, inc) x 5 – 20 sc

Rd4. (sc 1, inc) x 10 – 30 sc

Rd5-12 Sc in each sc – 30 sc

Rd13. (dec, sc 3) – 24 sc

Rd 14. (dec, sc 2) – 18 sc

Rd 15. in front loops – 2 sc in each sc x 1 rows

Fasten off, weave in ends

Shoulders

Change to head colour – working in continuous rounds ie no slip or chain at end of each row.

Rd16. In back loops, sc each sc – 18 sc

Head

Rd17. (dec, sc 1) – 12 sc

Fill without stretching stitches

Rd18. (Sc 1, inc) – 18 sc

Rd19. (sc 2, inc) – 24 sc

Rd20. (sc 3, inc) – 30 sc

Rd21. (sc 4, inc) – 36 sc

Rd22-24.sc each sc – 36 sc

Insert 7.5 mm eyes 8 sc apart

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Rd25. (sc 4, dec) – 30 sc

Rd26. (sc 3, dec) – 24 sc

Rd27. (2 sc, dec) – 18 sc

Rd28. (sc, dec) - 12 sc

Fill without stretching stitches

Rd29. (dec) – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave in hole

Arms –x 2 in main yarn

Rd1. Ch 2, sc 6 in second chain from hook or magic circle 6. Sl st – 6 sc

Rd2. (sc, Inc), sl st, ch- 9 sc

Rd3-4. Sc in each sc, sl st, ch - 9sc

R5. (Sc, dec) – 6sc

R6. Sc in each sc – 6sc

Change colour to arm colour. Working in back loops

R7. Sl st into any back loop, sc each sc – 6 sc

R8-13. Sc in each sc - 6 sc

Fasten off leaving tail to sew arm to body. Fill lightly leaving top of arm less filled than hand

R14. In hand colour 2 sc each in each front loop on wrist

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew to body

Legs and boots x 2 - in main colour

Rd1. Ch 5, Sc second chain from hook, 2 sc, 3 sc in next ch, turn work and in foundation ch, sc 3, 3 sc in last – 12 sc

Rd2. Sc 4, 2 sc in next, sc x 5, 2 sc in next , sc 1 – 14 sc

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Rd3. Sc in each sc using back loops – 14 sc

Rd4. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

Rd5. Sc 2, (dec) x 4, sc 4, - 10 sc

Rd6. Sc 2, (dec) x 3, sc 2 – 7 sc

Rd7. Sc 5, dec – 6 sc

Rd8. Sc in each sc - 6 sc

Fasten off, fill lightly. Change to leg colour.

Rd9. Sl st into any back loop, sc in each back loop – 6 sc

Rd10-18.sc in each sc – 6sc,

Fasten off leaving long tail to sew leg to body. Fill without stretching stitches leaving top of leg mainly unfilled. Sew to body.

Hat – In main colour

Rd1. Sc 2, with 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 sc – 6sc

Rd2. (2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc

Rd3. (Sc 1, inc) – 18 sc

Rd4. (sc 2, inc) – 24 sc

Rd5. (sc 3, inc) – 30 sc

Rd6. (sc 4, inc) – 36 sc

Rd7-10.Sc in each sc - 36 sc

Rd11. (sc 4, dec) – 30 sc

Rd12. 2 sc each sc – 60 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Top of hat – in main colour

Rd1. Sc 2, with 4 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 sc – 4 sc

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Rd2-4. Sc in each sc - 4 sc

Fasten off, sew to top of hat. Place hat on head

Wings – make 2 in white

Rd1. chain 6

Rd2. 2nd chain from hook, sc, hdc in next 3 ch, sc, fasten off – 5 sc

Leaves for Hat – Single Sided in green yarn

Rd1. chain 6

Rd2. 2nd chain from hook, sc, hdc in next 3 ch, sc, fasten off – 5 sc

Small Leaves – Double Sided

Rd1. 6 ch

Rd2. 2nd chain from hook, sc, hdc in next 3 ch, sc in next 2 chain, turning work, hdc in next 3 foundation chains, 1 sc fasten off – 10 sc

Large Leaves – Double Sided

Rd1. 11 ch

Rd2. 2nd chain from hook, sc, hdc in next 3 ch, db in next 3, hdc in next 3, sc in next chain, turning work, in foundation chains, hdc in next 3, db in next 3, hdc next 3, sc fasten off – 22 sc

Gumnut baby with yellow wattle skirt

Body worked in continuous rounds ie – no sl st to end each row

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Rd1. Ch 2, 10 sc in second chain or magic circle 10 sc – 10 sc,

Rd2. (sc, inc) x 5 – 15 sc

Rd3. Working in back loops - (2sc, inc) x 5 – 20 sc

Rd4. (sc 1, inc) x 10 – 30 sc

Rd5-12 Sc in each sc – 30 sc

Rd13. (dec, sc 3) – 24 sc

Rd 14. (dec, sc 2) – 18 sc

Rd 15. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

Rd16. Back loops (dec, sc 1) – 12 sc

Head

Rd17. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fill without stretching stitches

Rd18. (Sc 1, inc) – 18 sc

Rd19. (sc 2, inc) – 24 sc

Rd20. (sc 3, inc) – 30 sc

Rd21. (sc 4, inc) – 36 sc

Rd22-24.sc each sc – 36 sc

Insert 8 mm eyes 8 sc apart

Rd25. (sc 4, dec) – 30 sc

Rd26. (sc 3, dec) – 24 sc

Rd27. (2 sc, dec) – 18 sc

Rd28. (sc, dec) - 12 sc

Fill without stretching stitches



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Rd29. (dec) – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave in hole

With skirt colour ie yellow for wattle Sl st in any front loops from round 3, (repeat for front loops rd16)

Rd1. Sc in each sc

Rd2. 2 Hdc in each sc

Rd3. 2 sc in each hdc

Fasten off, weave in ends

With skirt colour ie yellow for wattle Sl st in any front loops
from rd16)

Rd1. Sc in each sc

Rd2. 2 Hdc in each sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Arms, legs, hat and wings same as for gumnut baby in gumnut
