### Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

### Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram - red
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity face colour, green and white
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 15 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

### Size

- cm in height

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Dc – double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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### Legs and Feet with sandals x 2 (worked in one piece – red yarn)

- R1. Ch 6, in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of chain, sc in each of the next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc (missed foundation loop from beg of row) – 14 sc
- R2. Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in last 3 sc – 20 sc
- R3. Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next, 2 sc in next, sc in last sc – 24 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R5. In back loops, sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R6-7. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round, for colour change – 24 sc
- R8. In leg colour, ch 1, in back loops, sc in each sc, sl st close round – 24 sc
- R9. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in each of next 3 sc, (sc2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 8 sc, sl st to close round – 18 sc
- R10. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in each of next 2 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7 sc, sl st to close round – 14 sc
- R11-14. Sc in each sc, in last st of R14, sl st to join round for colour change, fasten off skin colour - 14 sc
- R15. In red yarn, ch 1, sc in same chain space, sc in each sc – 14 sc
- R16. In back loops, sc in each sc – 14 sc

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R17-22. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

*Fasten off, leave long tail to sew up gap between legs. Fill without stretching stitches*

*Joining legs - with red yarn – legs are joined at centre side with 4 chain between each leg. Position markers at centre stitch of each inside leg, where the legs will be joined by the chain.*

*Sl st into first leg where you have placed the marker, ch 4, join with sc to second leg at marker, sc around second leg (14 sc), ch 4 to join again to first leg, sc around first leg (14 sc) - Join legs at centre side, 4 chain between each leg – 36 sc*

**R23. Sc in each front loop – 36 sc**

R24-27. Sc in each sc - 36 sc

R28. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 42 sc

R29-31. Sc in each sc - 42 sc

R32. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next) - 48 sc

R33-34. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

R35. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R36-37. Sc in each sc – 42 sc

R38. In back loops (sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R39-40. Sc in each sc - 36 sc

R41. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) - 30 sc

R42-43. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R44. (Sc in each of next 8 sc, sc 2 tog) – 27 sc

R45. Sc in each sc – 27 sc

R46. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R47. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

R48. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 21 sc

R49. Sc in each sc – 21 sc

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R50. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog), sl st in last st to close round for colour change – 18 sc

R51. Change to green, ch 1 sc in each sc – 18 sc

R52. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change – 18 sc

R53. In white yarn, ch 1, sc in same chain space, sc in each sc – 18 sc

*Fill without stretching stitches*

### Neck

R54. Change to head colour, sl st into any back loop, ch 1, sc in same chain space, sc in each sc – 18 sc

R55. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc)– 24 sc

R56. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R57. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc)– 36 sc

R58. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R59. (Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R60. (Sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 54 sc

R61-67. Sc in each sc - 54 sc

*Insert eyes 8 sc apart R66*

R68. (Sc in next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 48 sc

R69. (Sc in next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R70. (Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R71. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

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R72. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R73. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R74. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R75. (Sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends*

### **Nose – in head colour**

R1. Ch 4, sc in second chain from hook, sc in next sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of chain, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 10 sc

R2-3 Sc in each sc – 10 sc

*Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to face, embroider mouth*

### **Skirt**

R1. In red yarn, sl st into any front loop from R38, sc in each front loop – 36 sc

R2. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in same sc) – 42 sc

R3-4. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change – 48 sc

*Change to green yarn*

R5. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in each of next 5, 2 sc in next sc (sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 56 sc

R6. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change - 42 sc

*Change to white yarn, ch 1, sc into same ch space*

R7. (2 sc in each sc) - 112 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends*

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### Glove and Arm (Make 2) with white yarn

#### **Thumb**

R1. Ch 2, 4 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 sc – 4 sc

R2. Sc in each sc – 4 sc

*Fasten off, leaving long tail*

#### **Glove**

R1. Ch 4, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 10 sc

R2-3. Sc in each sc – 10 sc

#### **Joining Thumb to Glove**

R4. Sc thumb to glove, sc 4 sc around thumb, join to glove again with sc, sc around glove – 14 sc

R5. Sc in each sc - 14 sc

R6. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R7. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – sc 8

R8. Sc in each sc - 8 sc

*Fasten off white, in arm colour,*

R9. Sl st into any back loop from Rd8, sc in each back loops – 8 sc

R10-15. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change – 8 sc

R16. Change to red, sc in each sc – 8sc

R17. In back loops, sc in each sc - 8 sc

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*Fill arm, without stretching stitches*

R18. (Sc 2 tog) x 2, sc in each of remaining 4 sc – 6 sc

R19. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends, sew arm to body*

### **Hat x 1 in red yarn**

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 - 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) - 9 sc

R3. Sc in each sc - 9 sc

R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 12 sc

R5. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R6. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 15 sc

R7. Sc in each sc – 15 sc

R8. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

R9. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R10. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 21 sc

R11. Sc in each sc – 21 sc

R12. (Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc

R13. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

R14. (Sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next) – 27 sc

R15. Sc in each sc – 27 sc

R16. (Sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc

R17. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R18. (Sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next) – 33 sc

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- R19. Sc in each sc – 33 sc
- R20. (Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc
- R21. Sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R22. (Sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next) – 39
- R23. Sc in each sc – 39 sc
- R24. (Sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next) – 42 sc
- R25. Sc in each sc – 42 sc
- R26. (Sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next) – 45 sc
- R27. Sc in each sc – 45sc
- R28. (Sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next), sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off red – 48 sc
- R29. Change to green yarn, ch 1, sc into same ch space sc in each sc – 48 sc
- R30. (Sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next) – 51 sc
- R31. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off green – 51 sc
- R32. With white yarn, ch1, sc in same ch space, sc in each sc – 51 sc
- R33-39. Sc in each sc – 51 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends, roll white up to form brim*

### **Pompom x 1 in white yarn**

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in chain or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 21 sc
- R5-8. Sc in each sc – 21 sc
- R9. (Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc



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R10. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

*Fill pom pom*

R11. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 8 sc

R12. (Sc 2 tog)

*Fasten off leaving long tail, secure pom-pom to hat*

### **Small Pompom-in white yarn x 3 for hat decoration**

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in chain or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 8 sc

R3. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc

R4. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) - 12 sc

R5. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 10 sc

R6. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 8 sc

R7. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

*Fill lightly*

R7. (Sc 2 tog)

*Fasten off, leaving long tail, weave in ends, sew to top of hat*



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### Small Leaves – x 3 for hat decoration

R1. Chain 6, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, hdc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in next chain, turning work, sc 1, hdc in next 3 foundation chains, 1 sc, sl/st into start chain

*Fasten off, weave in ends, sew to hat*

### Large Leaves – x 2 for hat decoration

R1. 11 ch, sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 3, hdc in next 3, 2 sc in last chain, turning work, in foundation chain, hdc in next 3 ch, dc in next 3 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, sc in last

*Fasten off, weave in ends, sew to hat*
