One Piece Santa with Green Pants



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity face colour, red, white, green and black
- Size 3.25 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 12 mm safety eyes
- Purchased cord
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

Size

- 12 cm in height
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase

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Worked without sewing. First head, body and 1 leg, then second leg, then arms

R1. In head yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 sc – 6sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R4. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R5. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R6-11. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

Place marker at R9, where eyes will be inserted. Insert eyes 6 sc apart once arm positioning has been determined.

R12. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R13. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R14. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog), sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off head colour – 12 sc

R15. In white, ch 1, sc in same ch space, (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc), sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off white – 18 sc

R16. In red, ch 1, sc in same ch space, in back loops only (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R17. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R18. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R19. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

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Forming Arms

R20. (Skip next 9 sc, sc in 10th sc (arm), sc in each of next 11 sc) x 2 – 24 sc

R21-23. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

R24 In white, ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in each sc – 24 sc

R25. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change – 24 sc

R26. In green yarn, ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in back loops only – 24 sc

Forming First Leg

R27. In green yarn, sc in next 7 sc, insert hook into 12th st from hook, working back towards starting sc, sc in each of next 4 sc – 12 sc

R28-29. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

In last st, sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off green

R30. In black yarn, sc in each sc - 12 sc

R31. In back loops, sc in each sc – 12 sc

R32. (Sc 2 tog) until piece closed, or weave last 6 sc together until opening closed

Forming Second Leg

R32. With green yarn, sl st into closest stitch next to first leg, ch 1, sc in each sc - 12 sc

R33-34. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

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In last sc, sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off green

R30. In black yarn, sc in each sc - 12 sc

R31. In back loops, sc in each sc – 12 sc

R32. (Sc 2 tog) until piece closed, or weave opening closed

Fasten off, fill body and legs, being careful not to stretch stitches

Finishing Arms

R1. With red yarn, sl st into any sc from arm opening, ch 1, sc in each sc – 12 sc

R2. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 9 sc

R3. Sc in each sc – 9 sc

In last sc, sl/st to close round for colour change, fasten off red

R4. In white yarn, ch 1, sc in same chain space - 9 sc

R5. In back loops sc in each sc – 9 sc

Fill arm, being careful not to stretch stitches

R6. (Sc 2 tog) until gap is closed, or weave last few stitches until closed

Fasten off, weave in ends. Repeat for other arm.

Nose – in head colour

R1. Ch 2, 4 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 – 4 sc

R2. (Sc in next, 2 sc in next) – 6 sc

R3. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

Beard in white yarn

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc



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- R2. Sc in each sc - 6 sc
- R3. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R5. (Sc in each of next 3, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc
- R6. Sc in each sc – 10 sc
- R7. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 12 sc
- R8. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R9. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R10. Sc in each sc – 18 sc
- R11. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R12. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R13. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R14-15. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, whip stitch edges together, sew to face, weave in ends

Finishing Edges – in white yarn

- R1. Sl st into any front loop of R16 and complete 1sc in each front loop – 24 sc
- R1. Sl st into any front loop from R26, complete 1 sc in each front loop – 48 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Hat

- R1. In red yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2. Sc in each sc - 6 sc
- R3. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc
- R4-5. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

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- R6. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc
- R7-8. Sc in each sc – 10 sc
- R9. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 12 sc
- R10-12. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R13. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 14 sc
- R14-15. Sc in each sc – 14 sc
- R16. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 16 sc
- R17. Sc in each sc – 16 sc
- R18. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R19. Sc in each sc - 18 sc
- R20. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R21. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R22. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R22. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R23. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc
- R24. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change – 36 sc
- R25-27. With white, ch 1, in back loops only, sc in each sc – 36 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Pompom for hat – in white yarn

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in chain or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 8 sc
- R3. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 8 sc

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R5. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

R6. (Sc 2 tog)

Fill lightly, sew to top of hat, weave in ends

Gumnut Shaped Sack – in red yarn

R1. Sc 2, with 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle with 6 sc – 6sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next 1 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R6. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R7– 13. Sc in each sc – 36 sc

R14. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc tog) – 30 sc

R15. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R16. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc tog) – 18 sc

R17. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round – 18 sc

R18. Ch 2, skip 1 sc, (sc in next sc, skip 1 sc) sl st to close round – (18)

R19. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round – 18 sc

R20. 2 sc in each sc – 36 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends. Weave cord through loops in R18.
