

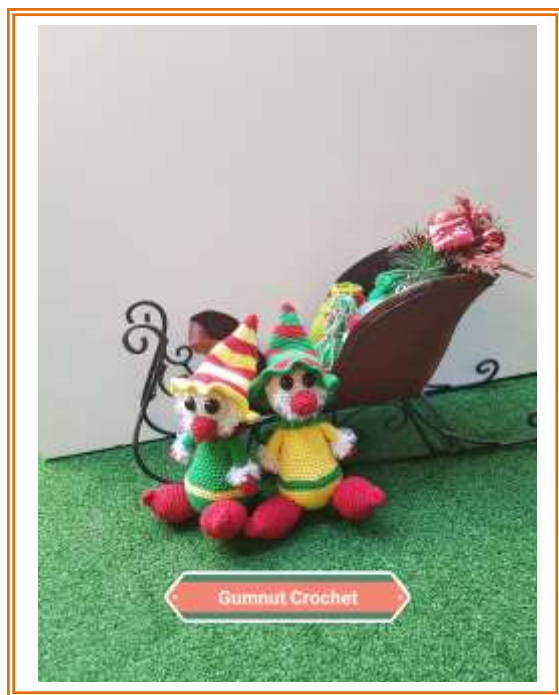
# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



and 1 metre of tape – Elastoplast roll or similar bandage tape, available from chemist

### Christmas Gnomes



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram skin colour (grey), green and red
- 4 ply cotton small quantity black
- Small quantity fluffy white yarn or 4 ply cotton in white if preferred. Moda Vera Flurry used in this pattern
- Size 2.0 mm crochet hook
- Size 3.0 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 15 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2
- If you are wiring – 1.5 metres of electrical wire – 3mm round, available from hardware store

### Size

- 20 cm with 2.00 mm hook
- When making toys, it is best to use a hook smaller than usual for the yarn type, in order to reduce filling showing through stitches

### Skill Level

- Intermediate

### Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – single crochet increase
- 2 hdc in next – half double crochet increase
- Sc 2 tog- single crochet decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Skip – skip next sc
- Dc – double crochet

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*Arms can be sewn on after body completed, but if you are joining them as per the pattern, make the Arms first and put aside until ready to join to body.*

### **Arms x 2 – In contrast colour**

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 9 sc
- R3. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 12 sc
- R4-5. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R6. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) 8, sl st to close round, fasten off yarn
- R7. Change to arm colour, sc in back loops only – 8 sc
- R8-16. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

### **Wrist Frill – in white yarn**

Sl/st into any front loop on wrist, 1 ch, 2 sc into each front loop. If using plain yarn, instead of a fluffy yarn, complete 2 sc in each front loop.

*Fasten off, weave in ends, fill lightly, put arms aside until body completed*

### **Choose either shoes or feet and toes for each piece**

#### **Shoes - with contrast yarn**

- R1. Ch 2, 4 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 4 sc – 4 sc
- R2. Sc in each sc - 4 sc
- R3. 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 3 – 5 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 5 sc
- R5. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc – 6 sc

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- R6. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc – 7 sc
- R7. (2 sc in next sc) x 2, sc in each of next 5 sc – 9 sc
- R8. (2 sc in next sc) x 2, sc in each of next 7 sc – 11 sc
- R9. (2 sc in next sc) x 2, sc in each of next 9 sc – 13 sc
- R10. (2 sc in next sc) x 2, sc in each of next 11 sc – 15 sc
- R11. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) - 20 sc
- R12. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 25 sc
- R13. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R14-19. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R20. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 25 sc
- R21. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) -20 sc
- R22. (Sc in next sc 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 15 sc
- R23-24. Sc in each sc – 15 sc

*Fasten off – sew up back of shoe, sew to body so that gnome sits without assistance*

### Feet in skin colour

- R1. In main coloured yarn sc 2, with 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle with 6 sc – 6sc
- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R3. (Sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R5-8. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R9. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

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R10. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R11. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R10. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R11-16. Sc in each sc – 36 sc

### ***Forming toes***

#### ***For big toe***

R17. Count 12 sc back from hook, sc across to that 12<sup>th</sup> sc, sc in each sc – 12 sc

R18-20. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R21. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 8sc

R22. (Sc 2 tog) – 4 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends, fill piece*

#### ***For next 3 toes – 8 sc for each toe***

R23. Sl st into sc next to big toe from R16. Sc in same space and next 3 sc, sc across piece into 4<sup>th</sup> back from hook – 8 sc

R24-26. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

R27. (Sc 2 tog) – 4 sc

*Fasten off, weave end closed, fill, sew up any gap between toes.*

*Repeat for 3 toes*

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### Body and Head – Worked in one piece – in main colour

- R1. In main coloured yarn sc 2, with 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle with 6 sc – 6sc
- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R3. (Sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc) – 18 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R6. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc
- R7. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc
- R8. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc
- R9. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 54 sc
- R10-16. Sc in each sc - 54 sc
- R17-21. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change, do not fasten off main colour – 54 sc
- R22-23. In belt coloured yarn, sc in each sc, fasten off belt yarn -54 sc
- R24. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 48 sc
- R25. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc
- R26. (sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc
- R27-28. Sc in each sc - 36 sc
- R29. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc
- R30-32. Sc in each sc - 30 sc
- R33. (Sc in each of next 8 sc, sc 2 tog) – 27 sc

R34-35. Sc in each sc - 27 sc

R36. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

*Fill, without stretching stitches*

**Joining Arms to Body** – Use markers to mark where the arms are to be placed. (It is 4 sc per arm with 8 sc between the 2 arms). Alternatively, sew into place when piece completed.

R37. Pin each arm to side where arm will be inserted. Sc through both layers of the arm and the layer of the body – 24 sc

R38. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 21 sc

R39. Sc in each sc - 21 sc

R40. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog), sl st to close round, fasten off yarn – 18 sc

*Collar –*

R41. With collar yarn, slip stitch into any front loop from R33, (ch 5, working down chain – sc in second chain from hook, hdc in next, dc in each of next 2, slip into next front loop, sl st into into front loop) x 9 – 9 petals

*Fasten off collar yarn. Fill lightly without stretching stitches. Change yarn colour to neck and head colour*

R42. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R43. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R44. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R45. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R46. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R47. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R48. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 54 sc

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R49-55. Sc in each sc - 54 sc

*Insert 15 mm eyes 3sc apart at R48*

R56. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 48 sc

R57. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R58. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R59. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R60. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R61. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R62. (Sc in next 1 sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

*Fill without stretching stitches*

R63. (Sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

*Fasten off, sew edge closed and weave in ends.*

**Nose – in red or skin colour yarn**

R1. Sc 2, with 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle with 6 sc – 6sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R4-5. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

*Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to face,*

**Beard – in white fluffy yarn – in size 3 hook**

R1. Ch 11, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each sc – 22 sc

R2. Sc in each sc - 22 sc





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*Fasten off, leaving long tail, sew to face*

### Hat - make 1

- R1. In main coloured yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 - 6 sc
- R2. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) - 9 sc
- R3. Sc in each sc - 9 sc
- R4. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next), sl st to close round, do not fasten off yarn – 12 sc
- R5. In contrast yarn, ch 1, sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R6. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 15 sc
- R7. Sc in each sc – 15 sc
- R8. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc
- R9. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round, do not fasten off contrast yarn– 18 sc
- R10. In main yarn, (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 21 sc
- R11. Sc in each sc – 21 sc
- R12. (Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc
- R13. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R14. In contrast yarn, ch 1, (sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next) – 27 sc
- R15. Sc in each sc – 27 sc
- R16. (Sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc
- R17. Sc in each sc – 30 sc
- R18. (Sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next) – 33 sc
- R19. In main yarn, sc in each sc – 33 sc



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- R20. (Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc
- R21. Sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R22. (Sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next) – 39sc
- R23. In contrast yarn, sc in each sc – 39 sc
- R24. (Sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next) – 42 sc
- R25. Sc in each sc – 42 sc
- R26. (Sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next) – 45 sc
- R27. Sc in each sc – 45sc
- R28. In main yarn, (sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next) – 48 sc
- R29. Sc in each sc – 48 sc
- R30. (Sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next) – 51 sc
- R31. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off main yarn – 51 sc
- R32. In contrast yarn, ch 1, sc into same ch space, sc in each sc, sl st to close round – 51 sc
- R33. 2 sc in each sc, close round – 102 sc
- R34-35. Ch1, sc in same ch space, sc in each sc – 102 sc

*Fasten off, weave in ends, secure to head*
