

Gumnut Crochet

Tooth Fairy – perfect for any 6 to 8 year old who is losing their baby teeth. Put the tooth in the pocket in the back and the tooth fairy can do a swap and leave the cash.



Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – main colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity for hat, tongue, pocket, teeth, eyes
- Size 2.00 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 15 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

Size

- 10 cm in height
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Dc – double crochet
- Dc dec – double crochet decrease

Tooth is made in 2 halves with 2 roots being a half. 2 roots are then joined together for front and 2 roots together for back

Tooth Roots – make 2 for front of tooth, do not fasten off second root (repeat from R1 to R23 for back of tooth)

R1. In main colour, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R4-6. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R7. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R8-10. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

Fasten off, first tooth but do not fasten off second tooth

Joining 2 roots together

R11. In main colour, sc across to second root, sc 22 around second root, sc back to first root, sc around first root – 46 sc

R12. 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 22 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 22 sc – 48 sc

R13-15. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

R16. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next) – 54 sc

R17-23. Sc in each sc – 54 sc

Fasten off. Complete R1 to R23 for second half

Sew eyes, nose and mouth to front of tooth, and pocket to back of tooth prior to filling.

Then fill without stretching stitches, whip stitch top edges together and sew back of tooth to front of tooth.

Eyes - in white x 2

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fasten off, insert 16 mm safety eyes, sew to front of tooth. Embroider mouth in red

3 mouth variations included. Choose either laughing mouth, tongue or teeth

Tongue – make 1 in red -

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc
- R3. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R4. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 10 sc
- R5-7. Sc in each sc -10 sc

Whip stitch top of tongue together, sew to mouth

Tooth – x 2 in white

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 8 sc
- R3-4. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Whip stitch top of tooth together, sew to mouth

Laughing Mouth

- R1. In red, ch 4, sc in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch, turn – 5 sc
- R2. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 6 sc
- R3. In black, ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 7 sc
- R4. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 8 sc
- R5. Ch 1, sc in same ch space, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 9 sc

R6. Sc around edge in black, working 2 sc in each corner.

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew to head. Embroider smile in black. Refer photo.

Pocket – make 1 in contrast colour

R1. Ch 4, 2 sc in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch, turn – 5 sc

R2. Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch space, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 7 sc

R3. Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch space, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn - 9 sc

R4. Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch space, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 11 sc

R5. Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch space, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn – 13 sc

R6-9. Sc in each sc – 13 sc

R10. Sc around edge of pocket, working 2 sc in edges

Fasten off, sew to back of tooth, weave in ends

Hat – make 1 in contrast colour

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or do magic circle with 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. In back loops only, sc in each sc – 12 sc

R4-7. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round in last st of R7, ch 1 – 12 sc

R8. In front loops only sc in each sc- 12 sc

R9. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 18 sc

R10. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R11. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly without stretching stitches, sew to top of tooth
