Easter Egg with Hat



Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x small quantity – main colour for egg and contrast colour for hat
- Size 2.50 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

Size

- 10 cm in height with hat extended
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Skill Level

- Beginner
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch

Small Egg – make 1 in main colour

R1. Ch 2, 6sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R4. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) -18 sc

R5. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R6. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R7. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 28 sc

R8-13. Sc in each sc – 28 sc

R14. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 21 sc

R15. Sc in each sc – 21 sc

R16. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 14 sc

Fill lightly, without stretching stitches

R17. (Sc 2 tog) – 7 sc

Fasten off, weave opening closed and weave in ends

Nose x 1 in head colour

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second cha from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to egg

Hat x 1 in contrast colour

- R1. Ch 2, 6sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2. Sc in each sc – 6 sc
- R3. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 8 sc
- R4-6. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R7. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 10 sc
- R8-9. Sc in each sc - 10 sc
- R10. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) - 12 sc
- R11-12. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R13. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) -18 sc
- R14. Sc in each sc – 18 sc
- R15. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R16. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R17. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 28 sc
- R18. Sc in each sc – 28 sc

Fasten off leaving long tail, secure to head

Neck Frill

- R1. Ch 25, sl st tog, being careful not to twist chain
- R2. Ch 1, 2 sc in each ch, sl st to close round – 48 sc
- R3. Ch1, 2 sc in each sc, sl st to close round – 96 sc

Fasten off, secure to base of egg, weave in ends
