

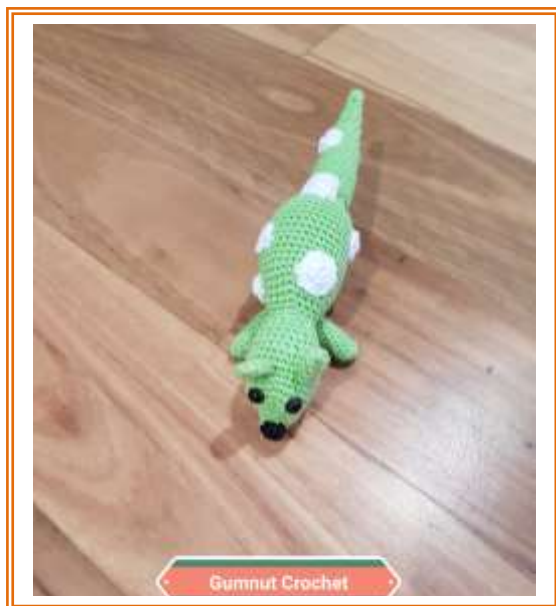

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x small quantity green and white
- Size 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 7.5 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

Size

- 19 cm long
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Skill Level

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Dc – double crochet

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Head – in green

- R1. Ch 2, 5 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 5 - 5 sc
- R2. (2 sc in each sc) – 10 sc
- R3. Sc in each sc – 10 sc
- R4. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 15 sc
- R5. Sc in each sc – 15 sc
- R6. (2 sc in next sc) x 5, sc in next 10 – 20 sc
- R7. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 25 sc
- R8. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30sc

R9-13. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R14. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 25 sc

Insert eyes – 4 sc apart

- R15. Sc in each sc – 25 sc
- R16. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 20 sc
- R17. Sc in each sc – 20 sc
- R18. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 15 sc
- R19. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 10 sc

Fill, without stretching stitches

- R20. (Sc 1, 2 sc in next) – 15 sc
- R21. (Sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next) – 20 sc
- R22. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) - 25 sc
- R23. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc
- R24-37. Sc in each sc - 30 sc
- R38. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) - 25 sc



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R39. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 20 sc

R40. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 15 sc

Fill lightly, without stretching stitches

R41. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 10 sc

R42. (Sc 2 tog) – 5 sc

Fasten off, weave opening closed

Ears – Make 2 in green

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 9 sc

R3-5. Sc in each sc - 9 sc

Fasten off. Whip stitch edges together. Sew ears to head. Weave in ends. Embroider nose and eyebrows

Tail x 1 in green

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2-6. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

R7. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) - 8 sc

R8-11. Sc in each sc - 8 sc

R12. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) - 10 sc

R13-16. Sc in each sc - 10 sc

R17. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 12 sc

R18-19. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R20. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 14 sc

R21-22. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

R23. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next) – 16 sc

R24-25. Sc in each sc – 16 sc



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R26. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

R27-29. Sc in each sc - 18 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to body

Legs x 2 back legs in green

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) - 8 sc

R3-10. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Fill lightly, fasten off, weave end closed, sew to body

Front legs x 2 in green

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) - 8 sc

R3-12. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Fill lightly, fasten off, weave end closed, sew to body

Spots – in white

Small x 5

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fasten off leaving long tail, sew to body

Larger x 2

R1. 2 ch, 6 sc in second chain from hook or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, sew to body

Tiger Quoll

The Tiger Quoll, Spot-tailed Quoll or Spotted-tailed Quoll is the largest marsupial carnivore surviving on mainland Australia.

Tiger Quolls, have white spots that extend along their tail. The Tiger Quoll has a large home range and can cover considerable distances (more than 6km) overnight. It is largely nocturnal and solitary and lives for about 5 years.

It is endangered or critically endangered in all states in Australia.
