- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Materials Used – makes 1

- 100 gram of chenille yarn (10 ply) for body
- Small quantity of 4 ply cotton yarn for bolero or small quantity of 4 ply cotton yarn for overalls – blue and dark blue used in this pattern
- Small quantity of 4 ply cotton yarn for nose and to embroider eyes
- Size 4.0 mm crochet hook
- Size 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Button for bolero or buttons for overalls
- Tapestry needle
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker

Size

- 28 cm in height

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Fphdc – front post half double crochet
- Dc – double crochet
- Dc dec – double crochet decrease

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Legs x 2 in main colour- no need to fasten off second leg

R1. Ch 2, 7 sc in second chain from hook – 7 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 14 sc

R3-6. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

Joining Legs

R7. Ch 1, sc across to second leg, sc around 14 around second leg, sc 1 across ch, sc back to first leg, sc 15 around first leg – 30 sc

R8. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc

R9. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R10-16. Sc in each sc – 42 sc

R17. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R18. Sc in each sc - 36 sc

R19. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R20. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R21. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R22. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R23. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc

R24. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc

R25. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R26. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 42 sc

R27. (Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc



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R28-33. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

R34. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R35. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R36. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R37. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R38. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

Fill lightly, insert eyes R40, sc apart

R39. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R40. (Sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends,

Arms x 2 in main colour

R1. Ch 2, 7 sc in second chain from hook – 7 sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc – 14 sc

R3-7. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

Fasten off, fill lightly, sew to body

Ears – in main colour x 2

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 9 sc

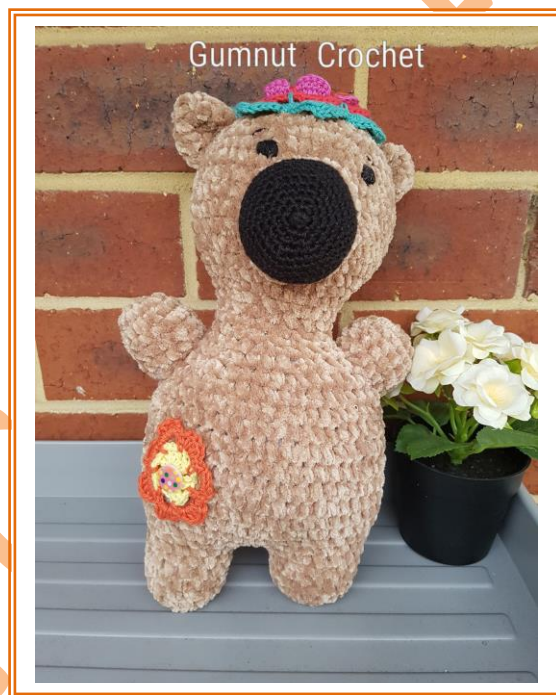
R3. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 12 sc

R4. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 15 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, whip stitch edges together, sew to head curved outwards slightly, no need to fill.

Muzzle – in main colour x 1

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook – 6 sc



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- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc
- R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc
- R6. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to muzzle

Nose – in black x 1 – 4 ply yarn – 2.5 mm hook

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc
- R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc
- R6. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc
- R7. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc
- R8. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next) – 42 sc
- R9-10. Sc in each sc - 42 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, fill lightly, sew to muzzle

Bolero x 1 with Contrast Yarn A and 2.5 mm hook

- R1. Ch 50, skip 10, sl st to form buttonhole, ch 3, dc in each of next 6 ch, (3 dc in next) dc in each of next 7 ch, (3 dc in next) dc in each of next 10 dc, (3 dc in next dc) dc in each of next 7 ch, (3 dc in next) dc in each of next 6 ch, turn
- R2. Ch 1, sc in each of next 7 dc, (3 sc in next dc) sc in each of next 9 dc, (3 sc in next dc) sc in each of next 12 dc (3 sc in next dc), sc in each of next 9 dc, (3 sc in next dc), sc in each of next 7 dc, turn
- R3. Ch 2, dc in each of next 8 sc, (3 dc in next sc), dc in each of next 11 sc, (3 dc in next sc), dc in each of next 14 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 11 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 7 sc, turn



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- R4. Ch 1, sc in each of next 9 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 13 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 16 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 13 dc (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 9 dc, turn
- R5. Ch 2, dc in each of next 10 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 15 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 18 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 15 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 10 sc, turn
- R6. Ch 1, sc in each of next 11 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 17 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 20 dc, (3 sc in next) sc in each of next 17 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 11 dc, turn
- R7. Ch 2, dc in each of next 12 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 19 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 22 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 19 sc, (3 dc in next), dc in each of next 12 sc, turn
- R8. Ch 1, sc in each of next 13 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 21 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 24 dc, (3 sc in next) sc in each of next 21 dc, (3 sc in next), sc in each of next 13 dc, turn
- R9. Change colour if desired, ch 2, (dc in next, 2 dc in next) x 7, skip 24, ch 4, (dc in next, 2 dc in next) x 14 skip 24, ch 4, (dc in next, 2 dc in next) x 7, turn
- R10. Ch 3, sl st in each dc

Fasten off, weave in ends, sew on button

Optional popcorn stitch flower, 1 for bolero – made with 4 ply cotton yarn

- R1. In yellow, magic circle, ch 2, 8 dc into centre of circle, sl st to close round, fasten off yellow
- R2. In contrast A, ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch), fasten off yarn - 8 popcorn petals
- R3. In contrast B, insert hook into space between a petal, ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch)

Repeat R3 for as many rounds as you would like. Decorate centre with button if desired, sew to wombats bolero at back

Overalls x 1 in 4 ply cotton using 2.5 mm crochet hook

First Leg

- R1. With dark blue, ch 40, sl st to join, being careful not to twist chain
- R2. Ch 2, hdc – 40 hdc
- R3. Ch 2, (hdc, fphdc) sl st to join round (40)

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Fasten off yarn, in light blue

R4. Ch 2, hdc in each hdc – 40 hdc

Fasten off light blue

Second Leg

Repeat as for first leg, but do not fasten off light blue yarn

Joining legs – in light blue (working in rounds ie sl st to close each round)

R5. Ch 2, hdc across to first leg, hdc 39 around first leg, hdc 40 around second leg, sl st to close round - 80 hdc

R6-10. Ch 2, hdc in each hdc, sl st to close round – 80 hdc

R11. Ch 2, (hdc in each of next 8 hdc, hdc 2 tog), sl st to close round – 72 hdc

R12. Ch 2, (hdc in each of next 6 hdc, hdc 2 tog), sl st to close round – 63 hdc

R13. Ch 2, (hdc in each of next 5 hdc, hdc 2 tog), sl st to close round – 54 hdc

R14. Hdc in each hdc, sl st to close round, fasten off light blue – 54 hdc

R15. In dark blue, ch2, hdc in each hdc, sl st to close round – 54 hdc

R16. Ch 2, (hdc, fphdc) sl st to close round – (54)

Fasten off yarn, weave in ends

Strap x 1 in dark blue

R17. Ch 50, hdc in 6 chain from hook (buttonhole), hdc in each ch, sl st to close

Fasten off yarn, sew one end to back of overalls where desired, sew on button at front.

The pattern for this flower is not included in this PDF. There are so many flower patterns to choose from. It has been included to see the head piece, but any large flower decoration would work just as well.
