Fairy Doll with Petal Head



Size

- 18 cm in height
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Skill Level

- Intermediate

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Tr - treble
- Dc – double crochet

Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – main colour - beige
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity contrast colour A and B – coral/ dark pink, yellow/teal and small quantity 4 ply tan
- Size 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 12 mm safety eyes
- If you are wiring – 1.0 metres of electrical wire – 3mm round, available from hardware store
- 1 metre of tape – Elastoplast roll or similar bandage tape, available from chemist
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker
- False eyelashes optional
- Felting wool optional
- Fairy or butterfly wings, purchased from Craft or Red Dot store. Many sizes will work with this pattern

Arms x 2 – In body colour (cream or light grey)

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc

R2. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 8 sc

R3-4. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

R5. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

If using wire, cut 16 cm of wire, fold and tape at one end to insert into hand. Fill hand lightly, crochet around wire. If not using wire, continue without wire.

R6-16. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, no need to fill arm, put aside until body completed. When body completed, insert wire through body where arms are to be positioned. Fold and tape hand edge for second arm and position arm. Sew into place securely.

Legs and boots x 2 – in brown / teal yarn

R1. Ch 5, sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of next 2 ch, 3 sc in next ch, turn working in foundation ch, sc in each of next 3 sc, 3 sc in last – 12 sc

R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, (2 sc in next sc) x 3, sc in each of next 4 sc, (2 sc in next sc) x 2 – 18 sc

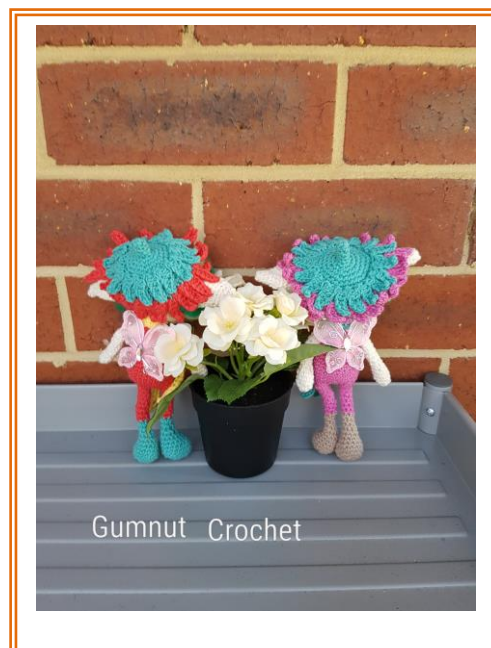
R3-4. Sc in in each sc – 18 sc

R5. Sc in each of next 4 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 6 sc - 14 sc

R6. Sc in each of next 3 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in each of next 5 sc – 11 sc

R7. Sc in each of next 2 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in each of next 3 sc – 8 sc

Insert prepared leg wire (24 cm) rounded at foot end, to shape boot, secured at ankle with tape, fill boot lightly. No need to fill leg as it progresses

R8. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 6sc

R9-11. Sc in each sc, sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off boot yarn – 6 sc

12-20. In body yarn (dark pink/ coral) sc in each sc - 6 sc

Fasten off leaving long tail to sew gap between legs.

Joining legs

Mark centre inner leg of each leg with marker

R21. Sl st into marked sc in 1 leg, ch 3, sc 6 sc around second leg, sc in each ch, sc 6 around first leg – 18 sc

R22. Sc in each sc - 18 sc

R23. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc

R24-R30. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

R31. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R32. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R33. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R35. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fill lightly,

R36. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 9 sc

R37. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog), sl st to close round for colour change, fasten off colour – 6 sc

R38-39. In head colour, sc in each sc - 6 sc

R40. (2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc

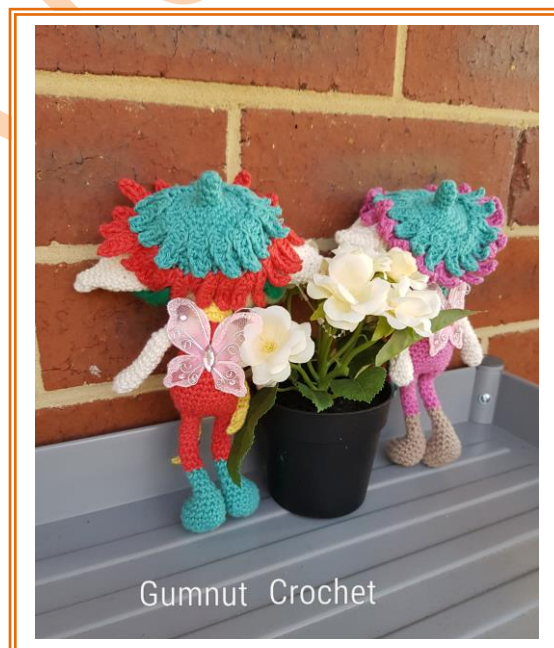
R41. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) - 18 sc

R42. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R43. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc

R44. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R45. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R46. (Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R47-53. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

Insert 12 mm eyes R53, 6 sc apart

R54. (Sc in next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R55. (Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R56. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R57. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R58. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

Fill without stretching stitches

R59. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R60. (Sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave end closed

Form nose by securing several stitches in head colour, to form nose. Sculpt mouth, by pulling thread through from top of head, to mouth and back through head. Using red thread, embroider mouth where it has been sculpted. Glue false eyelashes in place, or embroider eyelashes

Leaf Scarf x 1 in teal or yellow

R1. Ch 70, sc in second chain from hook, hdc in each chain to second last, sc in last – 69)

Fasten off, weave in ends, secure around neck, decorate as desired

Ears x 2 in head colour

R1. In head yarn, ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc

R2. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

- R3. (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) - 8 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R5. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 12 sc
- R6. Sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R7. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 15 sc
- R8. Sc in each sc – 15 sc
- R9. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) - 20 sc
- R10. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc
- R11. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

Fasten off, leaving long tail, do not fill, whip stitch edges together, sew to head with curve

Glue or sew wings into place. Wrap or plait felting wool, secure as hair under cap. Optional.

Cap – make 1 - in teal

- R1. Ch 2, 6sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 – 6 sc
- R2-5. Sc in each sc – 6 sc
- R6. 2 sc in each sc – 12 sc
- R7. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) - 18 sc
- R8. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc
- R9. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 30 sc
- R10. (In back loops, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc
- R11. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R12. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R13. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc), sl st to close round, fasten off teal – 52 sc

R14. With teal, sl st into any front loop from R10, (ch 6, sc into second chain from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, sl st in next front loop, sl st to next front loop) x 18 petals, fasten off teal

R15. In body yarn, sl st into any sc from R13, (ch 6, sc into second chain from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, sl st in next front loop, sl st to next front loop) – 27 petals

Fasten off, weave in ends, secure petals in place with cotton thread, sew cap to head once decorated.

Sew butterfly wings to back,
