Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – skin colour
- 4 ply cotton yarn small quantity for pants (white), hair colour (yellow), headband and bodice (green and red)
- Size 2.0 mm and 3mm crochet hook
- Piece of fabric for dress, piece of ribbon
- Tapestry needle
- 9 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2
- Builders wire, available from electrical section of hardware stores
- Bandage tape, available from chemists

Size

- 25 cm in height
- For toys, its best to use a smaller hook size than yarn normally suggests in order to keep the stitches close and reduce stuffing showing

Skill Level

- Intermediate
- A beginner who has access to google and u-tube, should be able to complete this project with some research into any stitches or steps which are unfamiliar

Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- 2 hdc in next – hdc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Hdc – half double crochet
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Fpdc – front post double crochet
- Dc – double crochet
- Dc dec – double crochet decrease
- Special stitch – Popcorn Stitch

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Arm x 2 in main colour

- R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook, or magic circle 6 sc – 6 sc
- R2. Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next – 7 sc
- R3. Sc in each of next 5 sc, (2 sc in next) x 2 – 9 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 9 sc
- R5. Sc in each of next 5 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 2 – 7 sc
- R6. Sc in each of next 5 sc, (sc 2 tog) – 6 sc
- R7-10. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

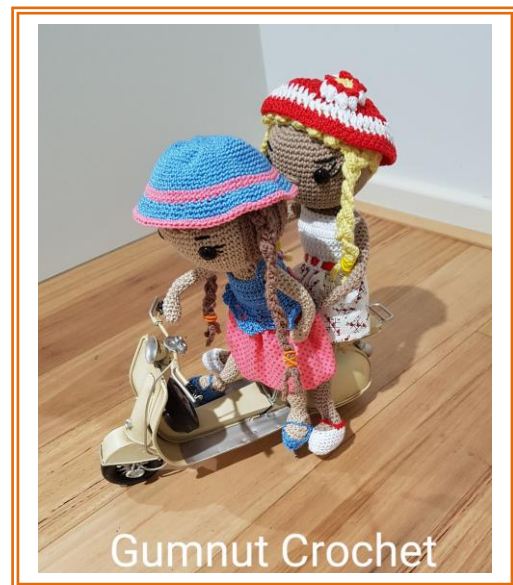
Insert prepared 25 cm of wire taped at one end into arm, fill lightly as piece progresses. Crochet around wire.

- R11-17. Sc in each sc – 6 sc
- R18. Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next – 7 sc
- R19-21. Sc in each sc- 7 sc
- R22. Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next – 8 sc
- R23. Sc in each sc – 8 sc
- R24. Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next- 9 sc
- R25. Sc in sc – 9 sc

Fasten off, fill lightly, put aside until body completed

Foot and Leg x 2 in main colour

- R1. Ch 7, 2 sc in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 4 sc in next ch, sc in each of next 5 sc – 14 sc
- R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, (hdc in next) x 2, 2 hdc in next, 2 sc in next, 2 hdc in next, (hdc in next) x 2, sc in next 3 – (18)
- R3. Sc in each – 18 sc
- R4. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in each of next 5 sc – 15 sc
- R5. Sc in each of next 6 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in each of next 3 sc – 12 sc

ch, 3

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R6. Sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 3 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in last - 8 sc

R7-10. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

R11. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc – 9 sc

Insert 22 cm of wire, taped at one end into foot, fill lightly as work progresses, crochet around wire. Increase stitches in following rows for leg, will be at the back centre of each leg.

R12. Sc in each sc – 9 sc

R13. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc - 10 sc

R14. Sc in each of next 10 sc – 10 sc

R15. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc – 11 sc

R16-17. Sc in each sc - 11 sc

R18. Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 8 sc – 10 sc

R19. Sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 2 sc, (sc in next, 2 sc in next) x 2, sc in each of next 2 sc – 11 sc

R20. Sc in each sc – 11 sc

R21. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in next, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 2 sc – 10 sc

R22. Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 8 sc – 11 sc

R23. Sc in each sc – 11 sc

R24. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 9 sc – 12 sc

R25. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

R26. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 10 sc – 13 sc

R27. Sc in each sc – 13 sc

R28. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 11 sc – 14 sc

R29. Sc in each sc – 14 sc

R30. Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 12 sc – 15 sc

R31-32. Sc in each sc – 15 sc

Fasten off, place marker at middle centre of each inner leg, where legs will be joined.

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In white yarn

- R33. Sc in marker on right leg, ch 3, sc in each sc around second leg, sc in each ch, sc 14 around first leg – 36 sc
- R34-38. Sc in each sc – 36 sc
- R39. Sc in next sc, (sc 2 tog) x 2, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 16 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 6 sc – 32 sc
- R40. Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 8 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2tog, sc in each of next 2 sc – 28 sc

Fasten off, change to body yarn

- R41. Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 13 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 4 sc – 26 sc
- R42. Sc in each of next 10 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 7 sc – 24 sc
- R43. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R44. Sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 22 sc – 23 sc
- R45. Sc in each sc – 23 sc
- R46. Sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 21 sc – 22 sc
- R47-49. Sc in each sc – 22 sc
- R50. Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc – 24 sc
- R51. Sc in each sc – 24 sc
- R52. Sc in each of next 8 sc, (2 sc in next sc) x 9, sc in each of next 7 sc (inc in centre front of body) – 33 sc
- R53-54. Sc in each sc – 33 sc
- R55. Sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 9, sc in each of next 7 sc – 24 sc

Joining arms to body

- R56. Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc in each sc around left arm, sc in each of next 11 sc around body, sc in each sc around right arm, sc in each of next 6 sc – 42 sc
- R57. Sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 9 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 5 sc – 37 sc

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R58. (sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) x 2, (sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) x 3, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog – 30 sc

R59. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R60. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) -16 sc

Secure wire for arms and legs through neck and tape together. Fill piece firmly without stretching stitches

Neck

R61. (Sc 2 tog) x 8 – 8 sc

R62-64. Sc in each sc – 8 sc

Head

R65. 2 sc in each sc – 16 sc

R66. 2 sc in each sc – 32 sc

R67. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 36 sc

R68. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 42 sc

R69. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R70. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 54 sc

R71-83. Sc in each sc – 54 sc

Insert safety eyes R77-78, 10 sc apart

R84. (Sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog) – 48 sc

R85. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42sc

R86. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R87. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R88. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) - 24 sc

R89. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R90. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

Fill piece, without stretching stitches



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R91. Sc in each sc – 6 sc

Fasten off, weave end closed, weave in ends. Embroider eyebrows and eyelashes in black. Embroider nose in head colour if desired.

Hair – 3 mm hook and hair colour

R1. Ch 8, sl st to join – 8 ch

R2. Ch 3, 14 dc into ring – (15)

R3. 1 fpdc in every dc – (15)

R4. 1 fpdc in every fpdc from previous round, 1 dc in each space between fpdc – (30)

R5. 1 fpdc in every fpdc from previous round, 2 dc in each space between fpdc – (45)

R6. 1 fpdc in every fpdc, 3 dc in each space between fpdc

R7. 1 fpdc in every fpdc, 4 dc in each space between fpdc

R8-11. Repeat R7 – 4 dc between each fpdc

Forming Fringe – Popcorn Stitch

R12. Ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch) x 6 – 6 popcorns

Fasten off, weave in ends

Braid – make 2 – 1 each side of fringe

R1. Sl st where you want the braid to start, ch 41, sc in second ch from hook and in each ch to end – 40 sc

R2-3. Sl st back to hair, sl st to next sc, ch 41, sc in second ch from hook and in each ch to end – 40 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, plait 3 together and tie off at base.

Dress with fabric base

R1. Ch 25, sc in second ch from hook and each ch to end- 24 sc



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R2-6. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 24 sc

R7. Ch 1, turn, (sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc

R8. Ch 1, turn, (sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc

R9-11. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 36 sc

Forming sleeve openings

R12. Ch 1, turn, sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 8, skip 5, sc in each of next 4 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 8, skip 5, sc in each of next 5 sc – 38

R13. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 38 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

R14. Sl st and sc in front loop of bottom edge, (ch 2, skip 2, sc)

R15. Ch 1, turn, (sc in first ch 2 space, ch 2, 4 dc in next ch 2 space, ch 2)

R16. Ch 2, turn, (skip next ch 2 space, sc in the first dc of group of 4 dc, ch 3, sc in the next dc, ch 3, sc in the next dc, ch 3, sc in the last dc, ch 3, skip next ch 2 space, ch 3, sc in next sc)

Fasten off, weave in ends

Finishing Back Opening

R17. Sl st, sc in top right edge opening, ch 7 (button hole), sl st back to sc, pick up sc evenly down back edge x 5, ch 7, sl st back to sc (button hole), pick up 5 sc evenly to end, ch 7, sl st to first ch, (3 buttonholes)

Fasten off, weave in ends

R18. Sl st, sc in top left right edge opening, pick up sc evenly down back edge to end

Fasten off, weave in ends. Sew on buttons

Dress Base

Cut a piece of matching fabric 10 cm long and 20 cm wide. Hem top and bottom edge of fabric piece. Sew together leaving 1 cm gap at top. Gather top edge, sew to bodice, matching gap with tops buttons and back edge. Sew lace or ribbon on as desired or leave as is.

Dress with Ribbon and Fabric Base

R1. Ch 27, sc in second ch from hook and each ch to end- 26 sc

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- R2-6. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 26 sc
- R7. Ch 1, turn, (sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc
- R8. Ch 1, turn, (sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc
- R9-11. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 36 sc

Forming sleeve openings

- R12. Ch 1, turn, sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 8, skip 5, sc in each of next 4 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 8, skip 5, sc in each of next 5 sc – 38
- R13. Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc – 38 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends.

- R14. Sl st to first foundation loop from R1, ch 3, (dc, skip 1, ch 1) to end

Fasten off, weave in ends, thread piece of ribbon through holes in R14

Finishing Back Opening

- R15. Sl st, sc in top right edge opening, ch 7 (button hole), sl st back to sc, pick up sc evenly down back edge x 5, ch 7, sl st back to sc (button hole), pick up 5 sc evenly to end, ch 7, sl st to first ch, (3 buttonholes)

Fasten off, weave in ends

- R16. Sl st, sc in top left right edge opening, pick up sc evenly down back edge to end

Fasten off, weave in ends. Sew on buttons

Dress Base

Cut a piece of matching fabric 10 cm long and 20 cm wide. Hem top and bottom edge of fabric piece. Sew together leaving 1 cm gap at top. Gather top edge, sew to bodice, matching gap with tops buttons and back edge. Sew lace or ribbon on as desired or leave as is.

Shoes

- R1. Ch 9, starting in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 7 ch, 3 sc in next ch, working back down foundation loops of ch, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last – 18 sc
- R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, hdc in each of next 3 sc, (2 hdc in next sc) x 3, hdc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in last – 23 sc
- R3. In back loops only, sc in each sc -23 sc

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R4-6. Sc in each sc – 23 sc

R7. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 8 sc – 19 sc

R8. Sc in each of next 6 sc, ch 4, skip 8, sc in each of next 5 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Boots

R1. Ch 9, starting in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 7 ch, 3 sc in next ch, working back down foundation loops of ch, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last – 18 sc

R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, hdc in each of next 3 sc, (2 hdc in next sc) x 3, hdc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in last – 23 sc

R3. In back loops only, sc in each sc -23 sc

R4-5. Sc in each sc – 23 sc

R6. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 8 sc – 19 sc

R7. Sc in each of next 8 sc, sc 2 tog, sc in each of next

R8. Sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 7, skip 8, sc in each of next 6 sc

R9-18. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends

Beanie x 1 in main colour

R1. Ch 2, 6 dc in second sc or magic circle 6 dc, sl st to close round – 6 dc

R2. Ch 2, (dc in next dc, ch 1), sl st to close round

R3. Ch 2 (dc in next dc, ch 1), sl st to close round

R4-6. Ch 2, (dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch space, ch 1), sl st to close round

R7. Ch 2, (dc in each dc, ch 1), sl st to close round, do not fasten off yarn

R8. In contrast yarn, ch 2, (dc in each dc, ch 1), sl st to close round

R9. Ch 2, (dc in each dc, ch 1), sl st to close round, fasten off contrast yarn

R10. In main yarn, ch 2, (sc, ch 1, skip 1), sl st to close round

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R11-13. Ch 1, sc in each ch space and ch 1, skip each sc, sl st to close round

Fasten off yarn, weave in ends

Popcorn stitch flower x 1 for beanie

- R1. In yellow, magic circle, ch 2, 8 dc into centre of circle, sl st to close round, fasten off yellow
- R2. In hat yarn, ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch), fasten off yarn - 8 popcorn petals
- R3. In contrast yarn, insert hook into space between a petal, ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch)

Decorate centre with button if desired, sew to beanie

Bag

- R1. Ch 9, starting in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 7 ch, 3 sc in next ch, working back down foundation loops of ch, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last – 18 sc
- R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 6, 2 sc 21 sc
- R3. In back loops only, sc in each sc -22 sc
- R4. Sc in each sc – 22 sc
- R5. Ch 2, (Hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2, (hdc, ch 1, hdc in same stitch), (hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2
- R6. (Hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2, (hdc x 2, ch 1, hdc x 2 in same stitch), (hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2
- R7. (Hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2, (hdc x 3, ch 1, hdc x 3 in same stitch), (hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2
- R8. (Hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2, (hdc x 4, ch 1, hdc x 4 in same stitch), (hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2
- R9. (Hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2, (hdc x 5 ch 1, hdc x 5 in same stitch), (hdc x 2, ch 1, skip 1, ch 1) x 2

Handle

- R1. Sl st into bag where handle is to start, ch 25, sl st at opposite end of bag, where handle is to finish

Fasten off, weave in ends

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Headband – in green

- R1. Ch 55, sl st to close round,
R2-3. (Ch 4, skip 2, hdc in next), sl st to close round

Fasten off, weave in ends

Popcorn stitch flower x 1 for headband

- R1. In white, magic circle, ch 2, 8 dc into centre of circle, sl st to close round, fasten off yellow
R2. In hat yarn (green), ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch), fasten off yarn - 8 popcorn petals
R3. In contrast yarn (red), insert hook into space between a petal, ch 2, (5 dc into same stitch, remove hook from the last dc, leaving loop exposed, insert hook into first dc, with hook still in the first dc, pick up the loop from the last dc and pull through both, ch 1 to secure stitch)

Decorate centre with button if desired, sew to headband
