Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

Stitches Used – US Terminology

- Sc – single crochet
- Fl – front loops
- Bl – back loops
- Ch – chain
- 2 sc in next sc – sc increase
- Sc 2 tog- sc decrease
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Sc dec – sc decrease
- Sc inc – sc increase
- Dc – double crochet
- Dc inc – double crochet increase

Bead Elf



Not suitable as a toy for a child under the age of 3

Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram for feet and vest
- 4 ply cotton yarn x 50 gram for body and head
- Small quantity fluffy white yarn or chenille yarn for edges and hat
- Size 2.0 mm crochet hook
- Size 3.0 mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 15 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill
- Stitch marker x 2
- Beads and fishing line for legs and arms
- Pom pom for hat

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Body x 1 in body yarn

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 - sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc

R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc

R6. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc

R7. (Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in ext) – 42 sc

R8-13. Sc in each sc - 42 sc

R14. (Sc in next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R15. (Sc in next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R16. (Sc in next 3 sc, sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R17-19. Sc in each sc – 24 sc

R20. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R21-23. Sc in each sc – 18 sc

R24. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R25. Sc in each sc – 12 sc

Fill body without stretching stitches

Head

R26. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

R27. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 24 sc

R28. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 32 sc

R29. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc)– 40 sc

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R30. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) – 48 sc

R31-38. Sc in each sc – 48 sc

Insert safety eye through white eye and place eyes 8 - 10 sc apart, in round 35 or embroider eyes

R39. (Sc in each of next 6 sc, sc 2 tog) – 42 sc

R40. (Sc in each of next 5 sc, sc 2 tog) – 36 sc

R41. (Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc 2 tog) – 30 sc

R42. (Sc in each of next 3 sc, 4 sc 2 tog) – 24 sc

R43. (Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc 2 tog) – 18 sc

R44. (Sc in next sc, sc 2 tog) – 12 sc

R45. (Sc 2 tog) – 6 sc

Fill head, fasten off and thread through remaining sc to close gap. Embroider buckle on belt if desired, embroider eyes, nose mouth and eyebrows.

Shoes /Boots and Legs - Make 2

R1. In boot colour - Ch 8, sc in second chain from hook and in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, continuing on opposite side of foundation chain, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc – 19 sc

R2. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in last 2 sc – 24 sc

R3. 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 7 sc, (2 sc in each of next sc, sc in next sc) x 2, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc – 30 sc

R4. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R5. Sc in back loops – 30 sc

R6 – R8. Sc in each sc – 30 sc

R9. Sc in each of next 8 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 6, sc in each of next 10 sc – 24 sc

R10. Sc in each of next 7 sc, (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 7 sc, sc 2 tog – 19 sc

R11. Sc in each of next 5 sc (sc 2 tog) x 4, sc in each of next 6 sc – 15 sc

R12. Sc in each of next 15 sc – 15 sc

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For boot – complete another 5 rows in sc – 15 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends,

R1. *In chenille yarn, sc in each second sc*

Fasten off, weave in ends

Leg

R14. Insert 45 cm of wire into shoe, wrapped at ends with tape to secure. Fill shoe and secure to shoe.

R15. Insert beads of choice for 7 cm, insert through body where legs are to be positioned, insert 7 cm of beads for second leg and insert into second shoe. Secure to wire.

Arms x 2

Thread beads onto fishing line wire to desired length and secure to body. Position 3 rows down from the neck.

Vest x 1 in foot yarn

R1. Ch 21, sc 20, turn

R2. Ch 2, (dc in ch st, dc in next 2, ch 4, skip 4, dc in each of next 3 sc) – 20 dc

R3. Ch 2, (dc 3, dc inc) – 25 dc

R4. Ch 2, (dc 4, dc inc) – 30 dc

R5. Ch 2, (dc 5, dc inc) – 35 dc

Hat in chenille yarn and 3 mm hook

R1. Ch 2, 6 sc in second chain from hook, or magic circle 6 - sc

R2. 2 sc in each sc) – 12 sc

R3. (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) – 18 sc

R4. (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next) – 24 sc

R5. (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next) – 30 sc



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R6. (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next) – 36 sc

R7-8. Sc in each sc – 36 sc

Fasten off, weave in ends, secure to head. Sew on pom pom.

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
