

# Gumnut Crochet

## Designs from Aus



### Skill Level

- Intermediate

### Gauge

- Gauge is not critical to this project.
- Different yarn type and different ply will change size.

### Stitches Used – US Terminology

- K – K
- P – P
- K2 tog – decrease, knit 2 together
- Moss st – k1, p1, alternative row, p1, k1
- Stocking st – 1 row knit, 1 row purl

**Knitted Jacket – designed to fit Gumnut Crochet Koala and Doll and Gumnut Amelia doll**



### Materials Used

- 4 ply cotton x 50 gram – main colour
- 2.75 Knitting needles
- 2.5 crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

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### Jacket - back

R1. Cast on 34 stitches

*R2-5 are moss stitch band*

R2. K1, P1 - (34)

R3. P1, K1 - (34)

R4. Repeat R2 - (34)

R5. Repeat R3 - (34)

R6-25. Stocking st - (34)

R26. K 2, K 2 tog to end, K last st

*R27-32 are rib rows*

R27. K1, P1 to end

R28. P1, K1 to end

R29. Repeat R 27

R30. Repeat R 28

R31. Repeat R 27

R32. Repeat R 28

R33-44. Stocking stitch (for Amelia Doll), cast off

R33-50. Stocking stitch (for Koala and Gumnut Doll), cast off

### Front – Right Side – (P rows are the wrong side of the piece for the right front)

R1. Cast on 21 stitches

R2. K1, P1 - (21)

R3. P1, K1, to last 4 stitches, k 2 tog, yarn over needle, P1, K1 – (buttonhole)

R4. Repeat R2 - (21)

R5. Repeat R3 - (21)



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- R6-11. K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, Stocking st rest of row. Keep band stitches for each row – (21)
- R12. Keeping pattern correct, at band edge make buttonhole (K 2 tog, yarn over, P1, K1)
- R13-25. Continue with stocking stitch and band pattern – (21)
- R26. Keeping band pattern correct, in stocking stitch section of row, k 2, k 2 tog, to end of row - 16 st
- R27-32 – ribbing pattern with band pattern at right edge
- R27-32. Keeping band pattern correct - K1, P1 to end
- R28. P1, K1 to end
- R29. Repeat R 27
- R30. Repeat R 28 – (form buttonhole in last 4 stitches of band section of row – K2 tog, yarn over, P1, K1)
- R31. Repeat R 27
- R32. Repeat R 28
- R33-37. Keeping band pattern correct at right edge, work stocking stitch for the rest of the row
- R38. Cast off band stitches, continue with stocking stitch pattern
- R39-41. Continue with stocking stitch pattern*
- R42-43. At neck edge cast off 6 stitches, continue with stocking stitch pattern
- R44. Continue with stocking stitch pattern
- Cast of stitches for Amelia Doll
- For Bear or gumnut doll, continue stocking stitch pattern for R45-50.
- Cast off stitches
- LEFT SIDE** – reverse instructions for right side omitting button hole rows. (k rows have band at end of row)
- The cast off rows for the neck edge are in the Purl rows for left side
- Cast off at neck edge is in Purl row

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## Sleeves

- R1. Cast on 28 – (28)  
R2. K 1, P 1 – (28)  
R3. P 1, K 1 – (28)  
R4. K 1, P 1 – (28)  
R5. P 1, K 1 – (28)  
R6. K – (28)  
R7. P – (28)  
R8. K – (28)  
R9. P – (28)  
R10. (K 1, K2 tog, k 2) to last 2 stitches, K  
R11. P  
R12. K  
R13. P

*For Koala Doll or Gumnut Doll cast off here. For Amelia Doll continue as below*

- R14. K  
R15. P  
R16. K 1, K2, tog K 2 – K last 2  
R17. P  
R18. K

*For Amelia Doll cast off here. Sew shoulder seams together.*

## Collar

- R1. Pick up 38 stitches evenly across top edge



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R2. K 1, P 1 – (38)

R3. P 1, K 1 – (38)

R4. K 1, P 1 – (38)

R5. P 1, K 1 – (38)

*Cast off, weave in ends*

*Sew sleeves into place*

*Sew up side seams. Sew on buttons*
